COUNTY COURT PASSES TAX ORDER

To assist here (Crocket) Monday, the Houston county commission passed an order authorizing the tax collector and county attorney to enter suit against all resident and non-resident property owners in the county who are charged with unpaid delinquent taxes. The court order that it deems such action absolutely necessary in order to meet the cost of operating the county during the current year.

The order of the court in full is as follows: On this, the 14th day of January, 1935, the court being in regular session, there came on to be considered; the financing of the county for the current year, and after due and careful consideration, it is deemed absolutely imperative that a larger percentage of taxes due the county must be paid in order to meet the just demands upon the county treasury. It is hereby ordered by the court that the tax collector and county attorney proceed under the law, as soon as practicable, to bring suit against all resident and non-resident property owners who are charged on the tax rolls of the county with unpaid delinquent taxes.

The court would respectfully cite the proper officials, tax collector and county attorney, to Articles 7225 to 7229, inclusive, of the Texas Constitution, which makes the bringing of tax suits to collect delinquent taxes, mandatory upon the proper officials. Houston (Crocket) County Times.

WOULD ELIMINATE SMALLPOX

Smallpox can be eliminated as a cause of illness and death if every person is vaccinated against this disease at least every five years, declared Dr. John W. Brown, State Health Officer. There were almost 800 cases reported to the State Department of Health in 1934.

Smallpox occurs most frequently among children under 14 years of age. The incubation period averages from 8 to 14 days, and the disease begins suddenly with a severe headache and high fever. The severe headache and the intense pain in the loins, back and extremities are more characteristic of smallpox than any other disease occurring in temperate climates. At the end of 3 or 4 days of these preliminary symptoms, an eruption appears which, within a few hours, becomes distinctly raised above the general level of the skin. With the appearance of the eruption, the fever subsides and the patient becomes more comfortable. In contradistinction to chickenpox, the eruption does not occur in crops, but goes through its development in a characteristic fashion, nearly simultaneously, all over the body.

At present, there is an increasing lack of vaccination among school children and they contribute a menace to our State.

It is right to sit still and to allow this disease to gain a foothold, when a very simple weapon is in a position which would make the occurrence impossible. Every citizen should be vaccinated by determining the amount of smallpox is wished to live. Vaccination is an economical measure easily within the reach of all and brings protection. The disease is within human control and our advice to the people of Texas is to get vaccinated if you have not been within the last five years.

A BASEBALL STAR IN PARIS

Consider the feelings of Babe Ruth, surrounded in Paris by some millions of Frenchmen, all speaking a language more or less strange to his ears and unaware of his existence. After creating so much excitement in Japan, that he virtually stood atop on its head, after receiving the plaudits of Japanese, high and low, who gave him a welcome such as no other American visitor ever received, and no other American visitor is ever likely to receive again, international relations being what they are, it must have been disconcerting for Mr. Ruth to arrive in Paris and discover that he was being ignored.

Had he been French, which he is not, he might have uttered one of those picturesque French oaths, like "name of a name of a dog," "ten thousand thunders" or "sacred blue." Not having the hang, as it were, of French, Mr. Ruth was forced to register disgust in other and more characteristic ways. Even the waiters in Paris cafes, who might have been expected to recognize an international celebrity by sight, paid him no more attention than they would a prosperous farmer from Iowa—if there are any prosperous farmers left or an old man from Texas. No wonder Mr. Ruth failed to generate any enthusiasm for the night clubs and was seized with acute nostalgia.

But the crowning humiliation was administered, it appears, by someone at the American consulate who inserted Mr. Ruth's name in a newspaper column of "unclaimed mail."

4,000,000 TREES WILL BE PLANTED IN SHELTER BELT

Washington.—Four million trees will be planted next spring, it was announced one day last week as a start on the forest service's vast shelter-belt designed to sweep from Canada to the Texas Panhandle.

The American Tree Association has had 23 of 30 planting areas had been selected tentatively, each calling for planting of 139,000 trees in strips five miles long and 10 rods wide. They will be established in the Dakotas, Nebraska, Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas.

Meanwhile, the forest service has collected sufficient seed of acclimated species to provide about 100,000,000 seedlings for planting in 1935.

Designed to provide windbreaks for cultivated land, the project was authorized by President Roosevelt with an allotment of \$1,000,000 in 1934. When completed, it will provide a belt of trees planted in the north with strips over a 1,000-mile
