Doc Roach To Get Tyler Co. Modern

If the Colorado and Brazos rivers can be harnessed to advantage for flood protection, power, irrigation and domestic water, there is no good reason why the historic Sabine and Neches should not be similarly developed, in the opinion of Representative J. T. Roach of Lufkin.

Dr. Roach believes in public works as a means of solving the unemployment problem. "I believe," he declares, "that unemployment relief can be solved by a large highway program on the State highway and County lateral roads."

He advocates no additional tax measures, believing that the people are bearing too great a tax burden already. In fact, he favors a definite proposal for reducing the load by exempting homes, up to \$3,000 valuation from all taxation.

His interest in public affairs has found expression in only one other public act, that of a member of the Lufkin city council. He is a member of the Methodist church and the Woodmen of the World. He is married and has five children.
