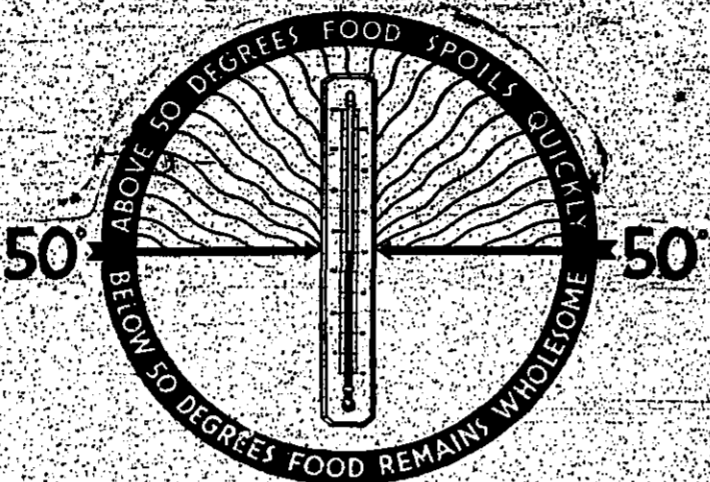

The Story of Cancer Control

This is Article one of ten such stories which are being published by request of the Hardin-Tyler County Medical Association.

No. 5

In 1930 the American College of Surgeons, consisting of a membership of some 2,000 physicians, recognized the need of coordinated efforts in the field of cancer control. They therefore set about emphasizing early diagnosis and effective treatment, convinced that this would materially aid in reducing the mortality rate. Since that time the American College of Surgeons has demonstrated the feasibility of this viewpoint by (1) urging certain well qualified members to specialize in this field and (2) by developing one hundred and forty highly organized special diagnostic and therapeutic cancer clinics in general hospitals. In these institutions certain minimum standards as to procedure, physical equipment and trained personnel must be maintained in order that the public shall receive all known benefits in this way the diagnosis and treatment of cancer is gradually falling within the province of highly trained physicians keenly interested in the effectiveness of the services of

The American Medical Association has been highly successful in focusing the attention of its members on the cancer problem. The results accomplished in the field of popular education alone justify comment. Through its component societies, five year cancer control programs are being successfully promoted throughout many states. In addition postgraduate studies and research are being stimulated by university
