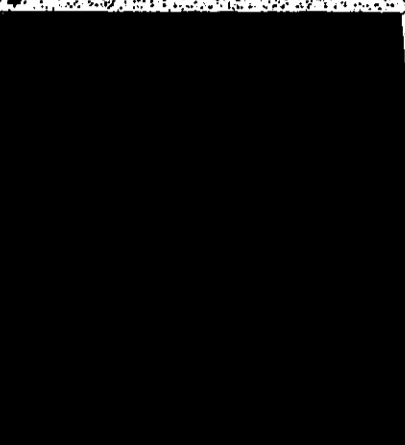

Planting Time For Fall Gardens

Most of the success of the fall gardens depends on preparing the soil correctly, including the following: Extension horticulturist.

The extension horticulturist recommended a heavy application of manure before plowing as started. He explained that summer manure which has no acids or burning ingredients, is used to increase soil water holding capacity and to break up the soil. The soil should be rich and moist. He went on to say that in many gardens, hard vegetables such as pepper, egg plant, tomatoes and lima beans which have survived the summer heat and are ready to produce a crop, should be cultivated. In sandy soils, the addition of one or two table-spoonfuls per plant of 6-7-8 commercial fertilizer will be beneficial.

Some gardeners do not take all in the garden but just planting a few things. They plant other vegetables such as Swiss chard, tender green, globe turnips and other leafy things of this type along with the old stand. The soil should be rich and moist. The soil should be rich and moist.

Before cold weather sets in pumpkins, cushaws, summer squashes and other vegetables of this type should be stored in a protected place. In the western part of the state, store these vegetables in the cellar. In the southern part, store them where ventilation will absorb the vegetable moisture and keep rot fungus down.

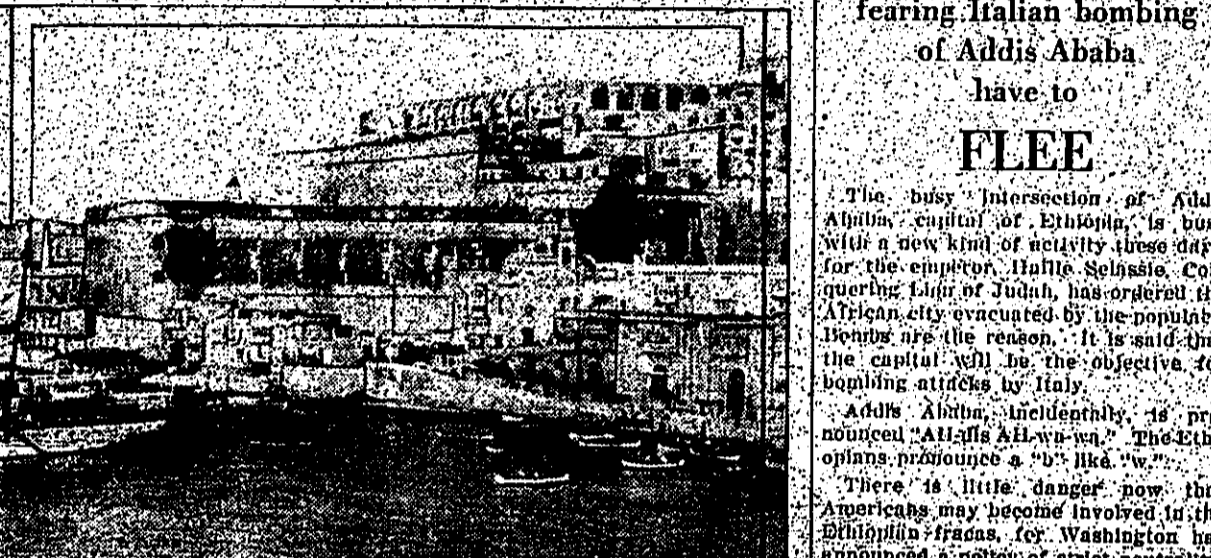
