### SLOCUM TEACHER HERO OF 1929 TORNA DO

Palmer, Sept. 15.—The homecoming celebration Sunday at Slocum honoring Thomas Gatlin, veteran school teacher and hero of the Slocum storm of 1929, will be so surprising to the school head, members of the arrangement committee had hoped.

Mr. Gatlin's coolness probably saved the lives of 150 children, and a child was killed.

In another building, however, one primary school child was killed and another died of injuries.

Principal speaker for the homecoming will be Congressman Nat Patton of Crockett. There will be impromptu speeches, sacred harp singing and dinner on the ground.

It isn't often that Gatlin has anything to say about the Slocum storm, which wiped out the village he has served as school superintendent for 23 years, but his control over school children on that occasion was an act of heroism and quick thinking that branded him as a hero in the eyes of the community folk.

### MANN SEEKS TO CLOSE INSURANCE COMPANY

Austin.—A forfeiture of charter suit was filed in district court here one day last week by Attorney General Mann against the Texas Mutual Reserve Life Insurance Company with headquarters at Tyler.

The suit alleged that the company is operating "illegally, fraudulently, is conducting a lottery, is insolvent, has accepted real estate in violation of law and has engaged in such fraudulent practices and activities as to require that the State of Texas file this suit."
