**STATE TUBERCULOSIS SANATORIUM**

The State Tuberculosis Sanatorium is one of the most successful hospitals in the South. White and Mexican patients are admitted for six months' treatment and training. (Negroes admitted to the Kerrville State Sanatorium, Kerrville, Texas). During their hospital stay, they are taught fundamentals of getting well and remaining well from tuberculosis. The institution stresses the education of the patient in order that he may return home following this reasonably short hospital sojourn and continue treatment which ultimately may bring about recovery. There are certain laws pertaining to the admission of patients which should be known by every citizen of Texas. Any bona fide American citizen of Texas between the ages of 5 and 60 suffering from early pulmonary tuberculosis or the

childhood type of tuberculosis, is eligible for admission. Adults must have resided in the State of Texas three years preceding date of filing application for admission to the State Sanatorium. Any child born in Texas, who may leave the state, is eligible after one year's residence preceding date of filing application. Payment for sanatorium care is divided into three generous groups: Indigent, free; Public Pay \$3.00 a week; and Private Pay \$10.00 a week. Regardless of paying status, all patients receive identical care and consideration. Patients are admitted only by application made on official blanks prepared by the sanatorium. These blanks may be obtained from the sanatorium from some local health organization or from a physician. In addition to a physical report to be made by a licensed physician, the application must be presented to the judge of the county court. All

signatures must be signed before a notary public. The admission of children should be made in the same manner, but an additional supplement sheet should also be filled out by the parent or guardian. The application and supplement, if required, should be mailed to the Superintendent, The State Tuberculosis Sanatorium, Sanatorium, Texas. All applications for admission will be reviewed by the Superintendent and will be accepted or rejected according to law. At present adult patients are being admitted to the sanatorium within a short time after their applications are accepted. However, it is necessary to place the names of children whose applications are accepted on a "waiting list" to be called as vacancies occur. No person should make the trip to the sanatorium unless notified by the superintendent that a vacancy is available. Patients received for treatment, except those taking a certain type of collapse therapy, will be permitted to remain in the sanatorium for six months, at the expiration of which time they shall be dismissed. All correspondence in regard to the admission of patients, the physical condition of any patient in the sanatorium or any other information, should be addressed to the superintendent. Literature in regard to the study and prevention of tuberculosis may be obtained by writing the Division of Correspondence, State Tuberculosis Sanatorium, Sanatorium, Texas.
