Co. Red Cross Held Yesterday

Calling all Red Cross workers a "people's partnership," J. I. Finner, ranking vice chairman of the national organization with headquarters in Washington, struck the keynote of a meeting of about 125 workers in this organization who met Wednesday evening at the Masonic temple in Port Arthur to discuss the imminent War Fund drive.

Truman Silverard, regional director of chapter service, and Mrs. Tess Fetter, held representative, both of St. Louis, spoke at length of aims and war goals of the Red Cross, with emphasis on Texas' part, which they termed constantly generous.

Mr. Silverard's statement that the whole effort had been stepped up 400% in 12 months emphasized the size of the job he described could be successful only through the untold effort of all groups: farm workers, labor, clubs, churches and family.

He gave detailed accounts of the allocation of the \$125,000,000 national drive goal, this to be expended as follows: \$60,000,000 for the armed forces for all purposes; \$20,000,000 for disaster relief; \$25,000,000 for foreign war relief; \$20,000,000 for medical supplies; \$10,000,000 for chapter services; \$10,000,000 for several other miscellaneous purposes, including chapter expenses.

It was pointed out that there had been a definite arrangement made through the United States government that there be no competition in funds in collection throughout the month of March.

Rev. Gen. Marston, Port Arthur chapter head, being absent, Mrs. C. F. Peterson of the Port Arthur Red Cross, presided. Rev. Mr. Marston was in Washington on official business for the chapter. V. M. Harrah, field director of camp and hospital service, was a special guest. County Chairman, C. K. Smith and wife, and T. E. Stuber attended this meeting.

They had during their brief been some pay-as-you-go plan may be adopted later. Americans will do well to remember that late returns must be filed March 15th and at least one-quarter of the tax paid. Payment will not be prejudicial to any benefits which may be received under any new tax law.
