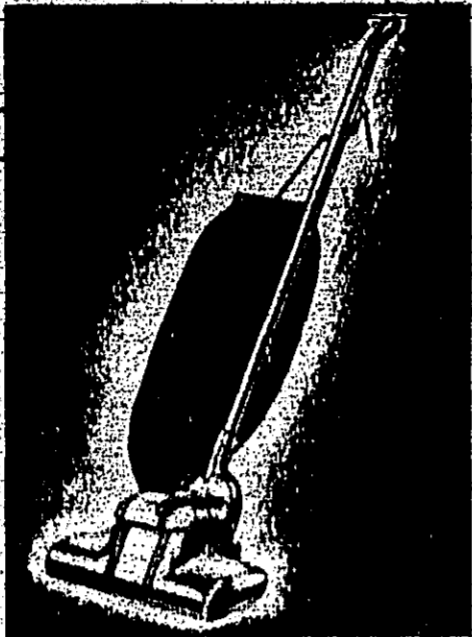

TIPS ON CLEANER CARE

- Suction filter bag every time cleaner is used. Don't bag unless suction is good.
- Avoid cleaning flammable or oily spots, mats, coats and other hard objects. Pick them up by hand.
- Keep the filter free from lint, hair and threads. Clean after each use.
- If vacuum is not picking up threads, check belt to see if it is running freely. Increase tension if replace belt thinner.

- Be sure that brush is properly adjusted. Brushes should extend about one eighth inch below floor.
- Engaged loosely on back. Pulling too tightly may break when inside motor. Then wheel and brush over back.
- Disconnect cord by grasping plug at outlet. Do not yank cord or you may damage connection.
- Follow manufacturer's instructions on cleaning and oiling. Consult your dealer if you have any questions.
