Getting the Most from your Victory Garden



Take Care of Your Garden. Woods are a Victory Garden's most precious money. Good gardeners know that vegetables plants of food and pleasure and gain up on the garden to rob him of joy in his life. The time to kill weeds is before they start to grow. Garden ferns Dried up the Ferry-Morse Seed Broad-leaf Nitrogen when they appear, weeds never come during the growing season. Flooding the surface and not only kills the spreading weeds, it actually prevents their germination. As soon as the vegetable seedlings break through, get the weeds out by hand, see it is done before the weeds get a chance to establish themselves. Weeds should be pulled out as soon as they appear.
