CONGRESS APPROVES BILL FOR PREREQUISITE OF U. S. AGENCIES

Washington, Jan. 20.—The House committee today passed a bill to strip federal government departments of their fee-making jurisdiction—an action that would boost the post office revenue by an estimated \$20,000,000 a year.

The legislation, which is a wartime expedient, the House and Navy departments, the Treasury and selective service. The committee, headed by Senator Byrd, Democrat, Virginia, is investigating the postoffice's operations.

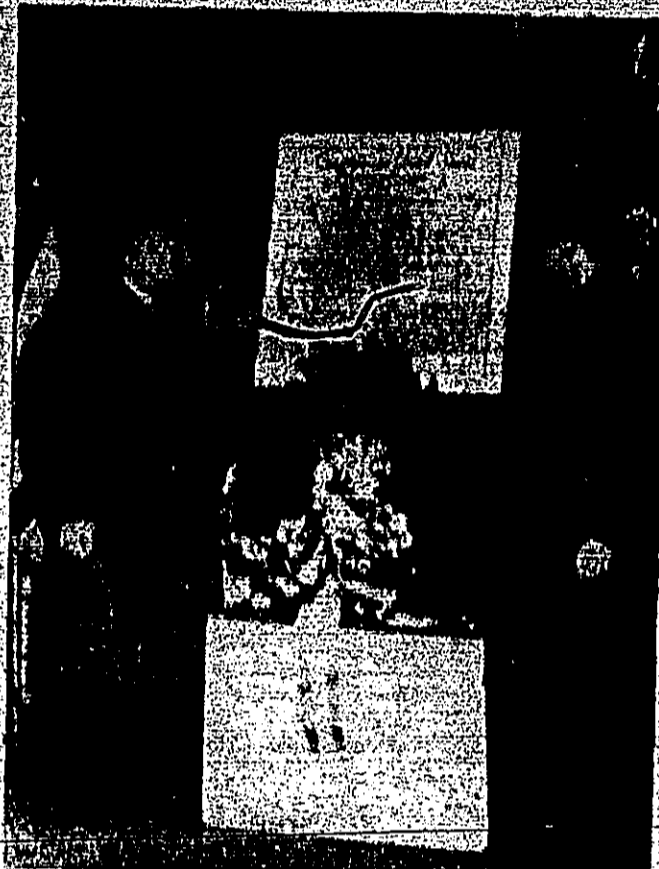

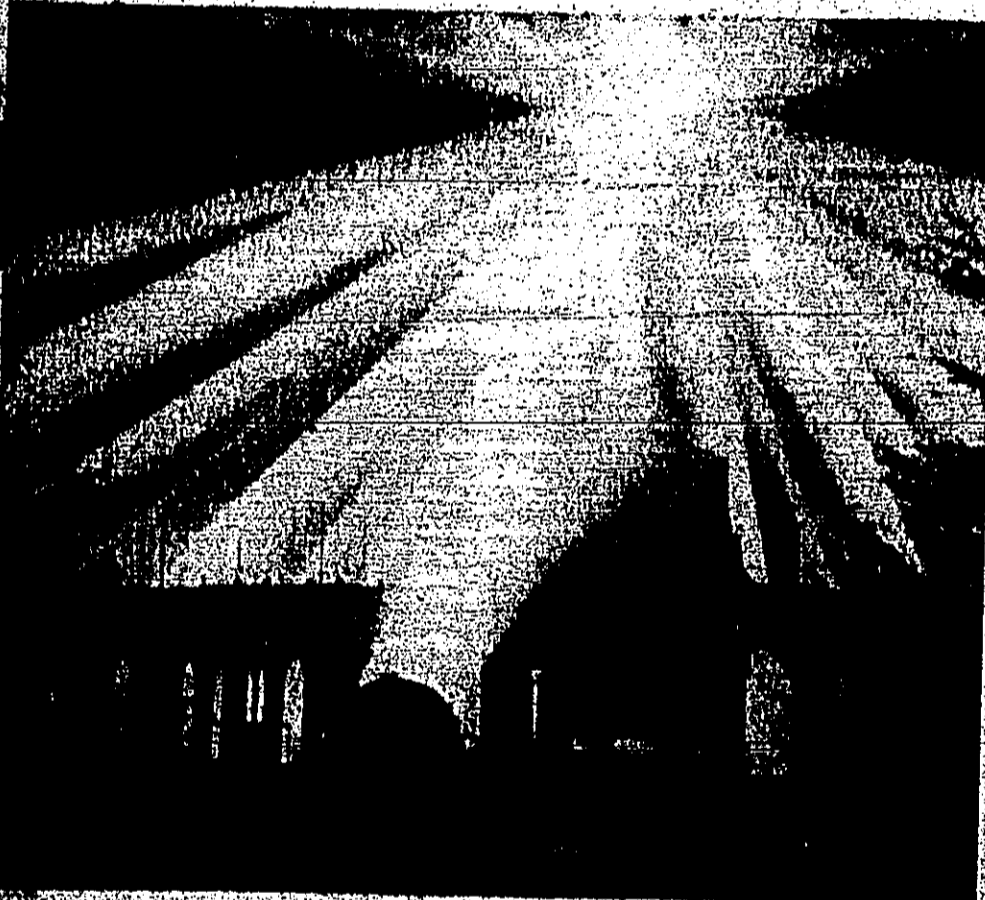

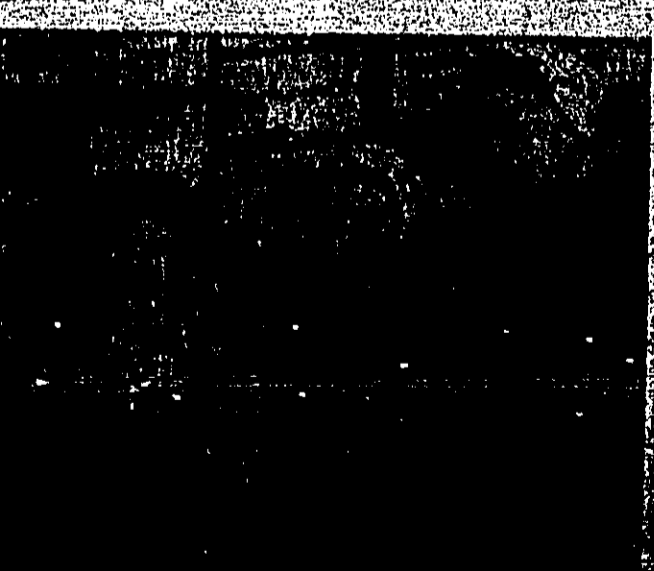

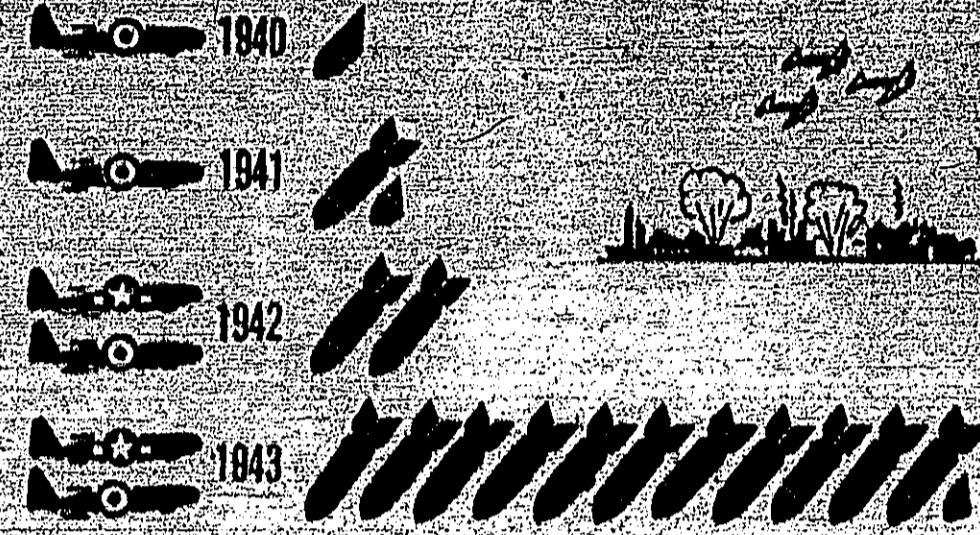

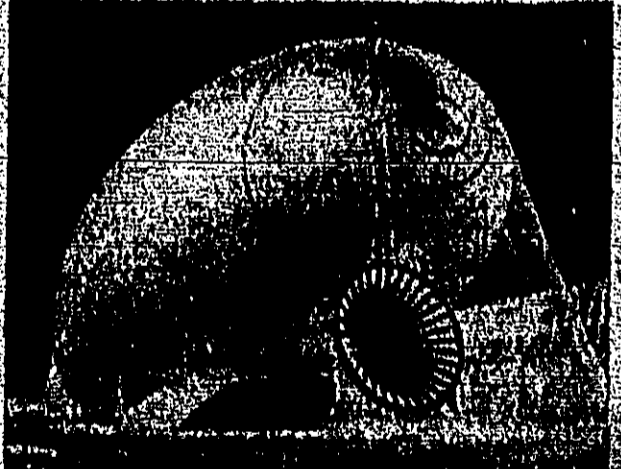

OUR REVERIES

The Rocket Plane

British-American engineers have developed a rocket plane capable of operating at high altitudes without the aid of propellers. The plane is powered with jet propulsion. Jet propulsion is general in aviation circles to be a principle, but the rocket principle, hitherto the plane for war. Aviation authorities have said that today's airplane has just about reached its limit in speed at close to 600 miles an hour. 
