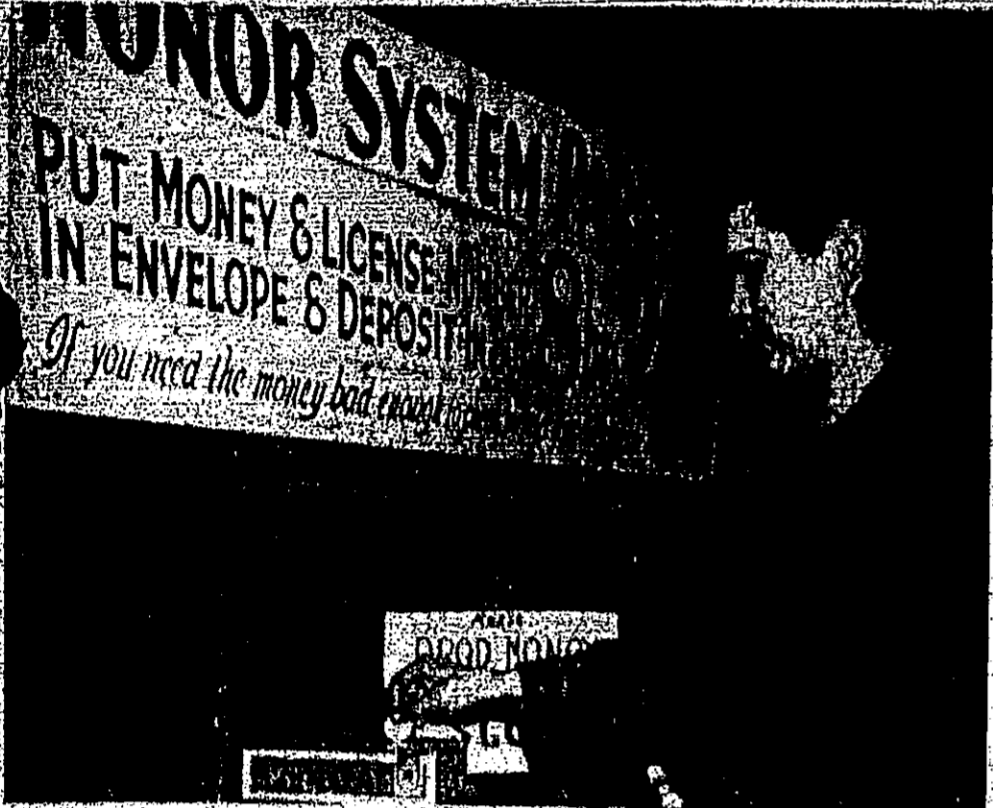

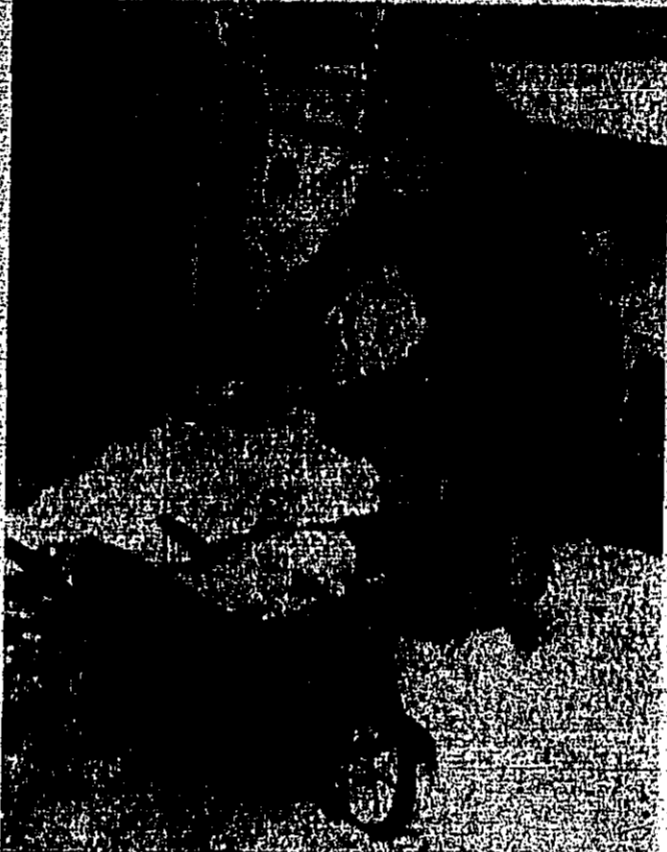

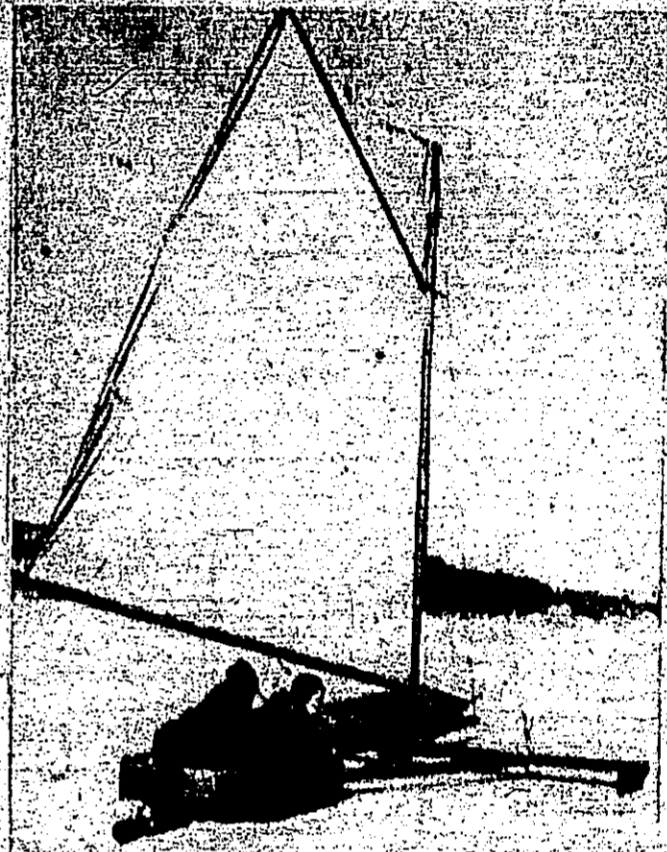

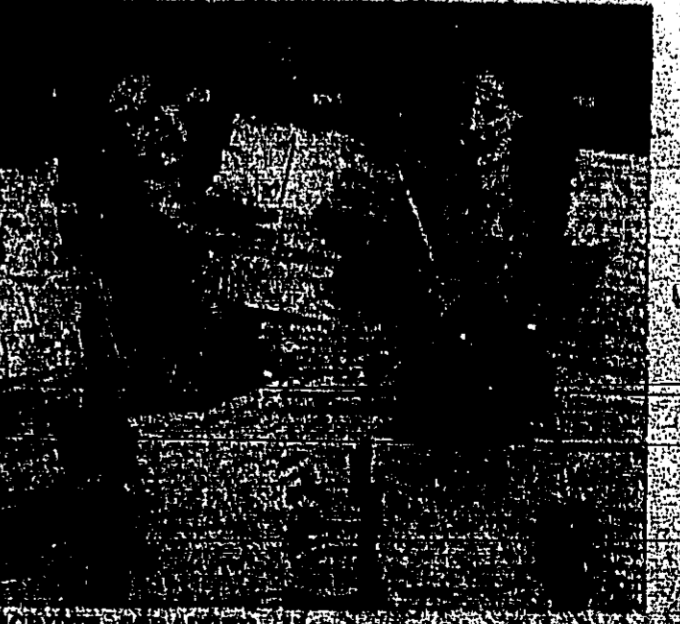

**A**MERICAN armed forces operating in the South-Central Pacific have recently achieved two great victories over Japan. The first victory was gained on February 2 at Kwajalein Atoll in the Marshalls Islands.

The second victory was gained on February 16 at Truk, Japan's main base in the isolated Caroline Islands.

By taking the Marshalls, the Navy has broken the Japanese line of defense in the Pacific. Japan's holding the islands under military rule would have made them a barrier and a base for the Japanese to launch their drive into the Pacific.

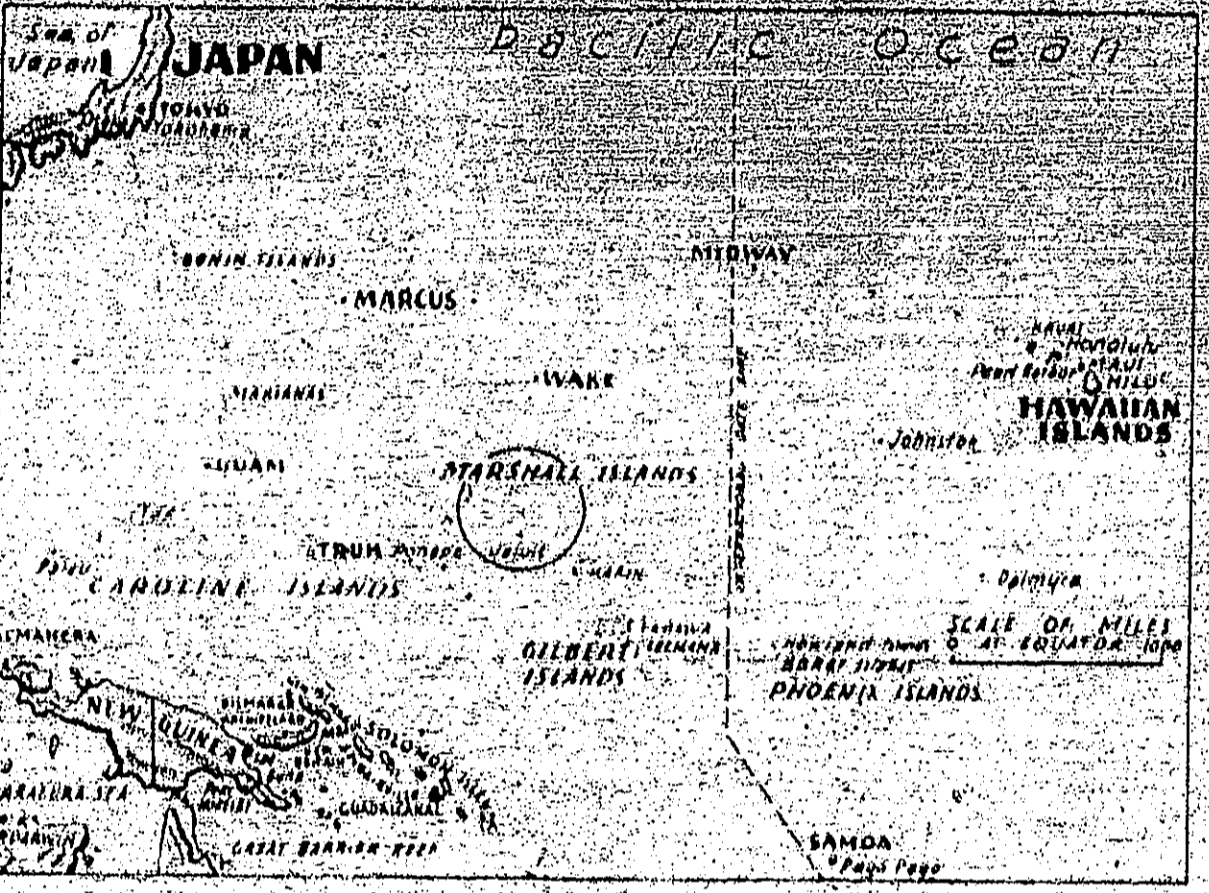

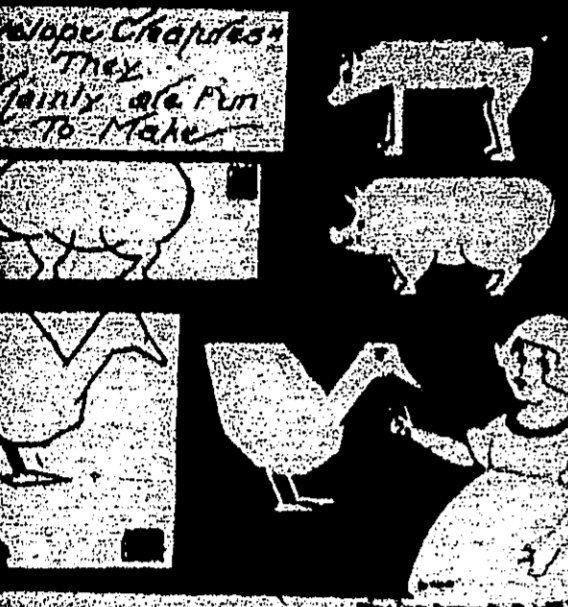
