Pat's got more iron on her mind than any other one thing. Always stand your iron carefully on the floor and be sure landing board is level and not tipping. And follow these other tips for longer life and better service:

- Never immerse your iron in water. It may cause a "short" in heating elements.
- Don't iron over clothes, towels and other hard articles. It scratches the plate.
- Don't let cord touch hot iron or plug continuously on edge of trailing board.
- Always connect iron by inserting iron plug first, then outlet plug. Reverse procedure to disconnect.
- Don't yank cord loose from outlet. Grasp plug in fingers.
- Be sure iron is perfectly cold before putting it away.
- To cure a sticky iron, heat it and rub it over a waxed bread wrapper that has been sprinkled with salt. This also waxes sole plate.

No one can say for sure when iron will again be available in quantity, so take good care of the one you have. Make it last!
