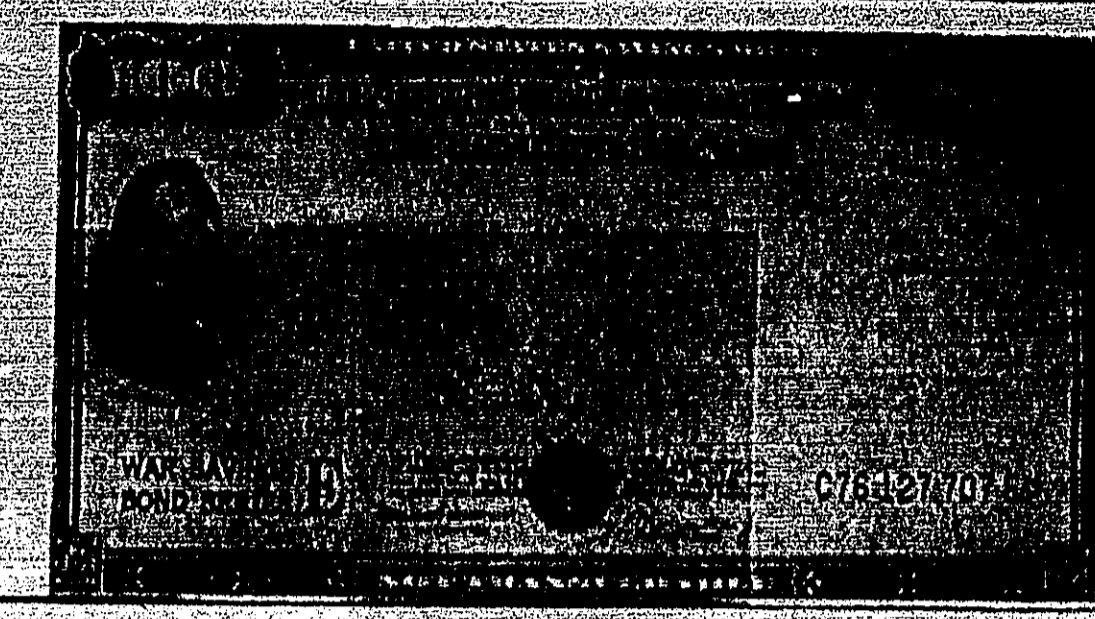

WASHINGTON, D. C.—The nation's 30,000,000 school children are again all set to assume a much responsible part in given them in helping to meet the \$7,000,000,000 quota set for sales of War Bonds to individuals in the Seventh War Loan. The demonstrated sales effectiveness of school children was an important factor in the determination of the date and for this new drive—May 14th through June 30th, inclusive on the part of many War Loan administrators have given previous Bond Drives. A recent survey reveals that more than 30 million people heard about the 7th War Loan from school children. Over seven million were directly asked to buy bonds by boys and girls, a little less than a third of whom were selected in no other way. The participation of school children ranges from rallies at their schools to the taking over of school houses to house-to-house canvassing. In Penn. Grove, Pa., small New Jersey town, during the last War Loan drive, school children were leading behind, in cooperation with the War Finance Committee, turned out to be the largest group of high school and college students. If the adults were to have the same success as the children in the past, the drive would be a success.

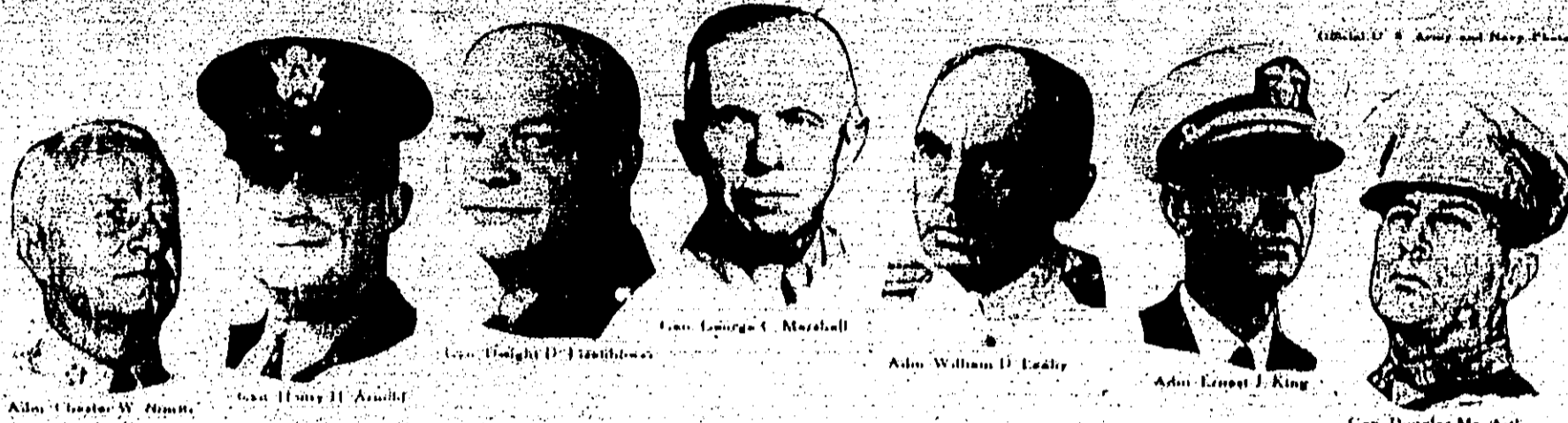
