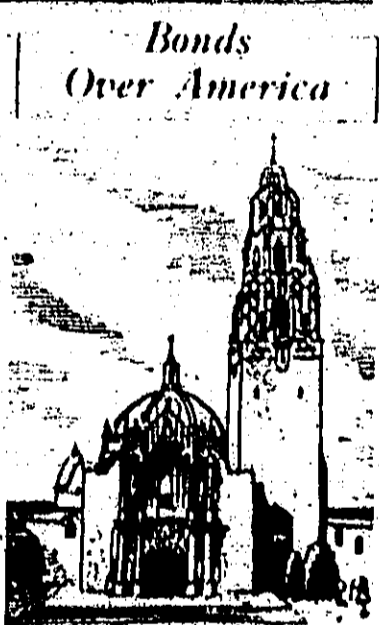

New draft regulations deferring men over 29 apply only to those whose work contributes to war production, essential agriculture or the national health, safety and interest.
