Through snow and ice and heat, Southern Pacific men and machines battle the toughest railroad geography in the country, and they've won. 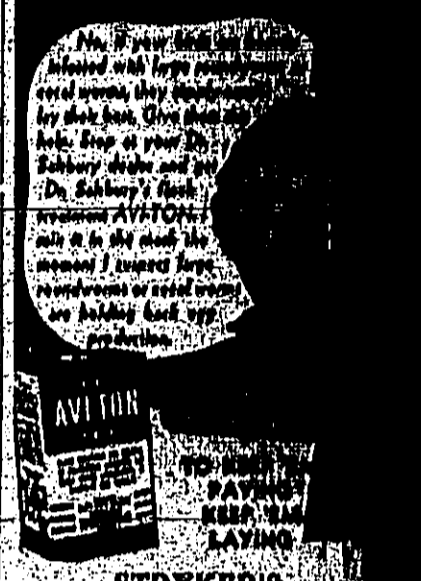

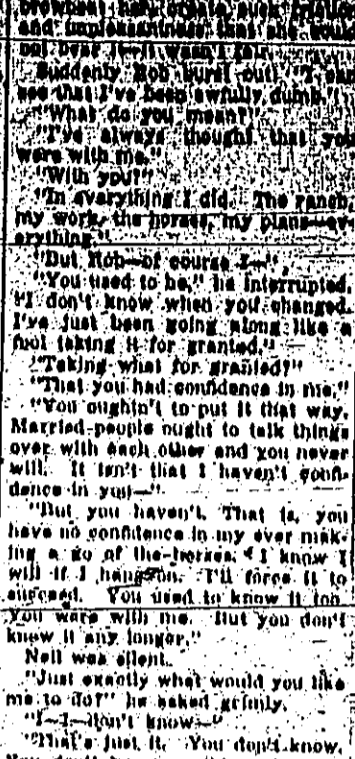
