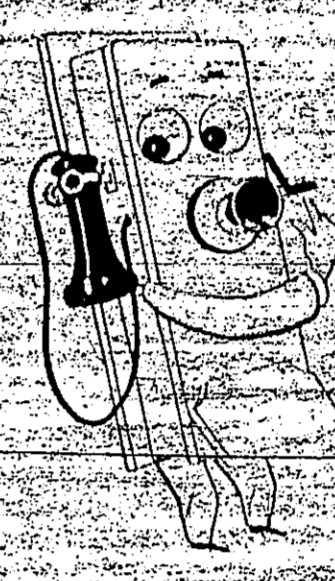

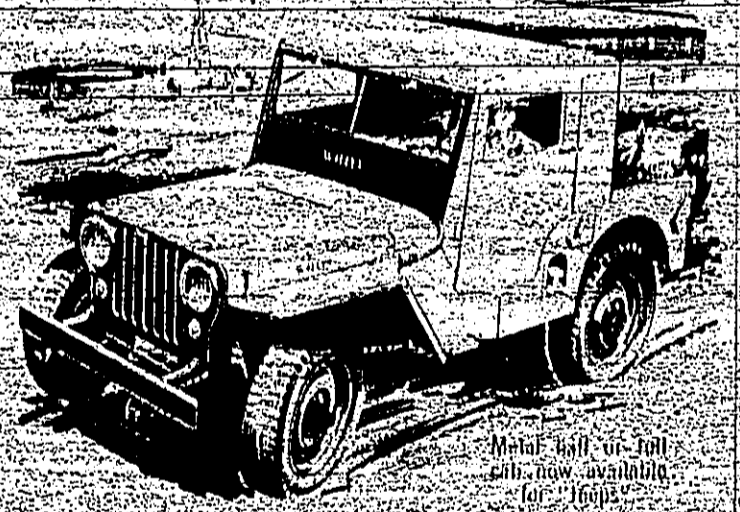

Proper Way To Make Right Turn

If you want to do a good turn for your neighbor and your fellow driver, learn the proper way to make a right turn while driving.

In cooperation with a nationwide "Learn and Obey Traffic Laws" program...

1. Keep as close as possible to the right edge of the roadway both before and after turning. Don't swing out.

2. Don't forget to make the hand signal well in advance of the turn.

3. Anticipate the turn far enough in advance so you can hold the proper lane. This means keeping your mind on your driving.

4. Keep close to the right after turning to cause a minimum of interference with the traffic flow you are entering.
