Texas Forest Service Majors In Fire Control

Mechanical equipment for the Texas Forest Service has replaced hand tools insofar as available funds permitted. Radios have replaced telephones in lookout towers and most fire fighting vehicles, air-staff and headquarters are equipped with two-way radio communication.

Another important step of the Texas Forest Service in the past decade of modernization has been the adaptation of the airplane to a role in fire detection.

This use of the airplane and the two-way radio for sky scouting missions has greatly enhanced the efficiency of the department in its never-ending fight against forest fires.

The officials and employees of the Texas Forest Service are to be commended for their alertness and achievement in protecting one of the state's vital resources.
