

Office, P. O. Box 908, Lufkin, With the coming of spring, Comte points out that a few simple precautions can be taken to prevent these fires from es-

> caping. First, for trash burning, use an enclosed burner with a cover sosparks cannot escape. Second, when burning brush in clearing operations, the piles should be kept small and the material added to the fire a little at the time. Clean an area to bare soil for about six feet around the materail and all piles should be encircled with a 8-10 foot wide plowed ar disked firebreak. Starting the fire should be delayed until the late afternoon when the air is quiet and cool. Most important someone should remain with the fire un-

til it is dead out.


