Friday will begin a long Fourth of July holiday for most people, and for some it will be their last. The Department of Public Safety predicts that there will be 31 traffic fatalities during the three-day holiday period. The prediction is based on past experience and present trends in driving.

Traffic accidents are up all over the state and especially in the Beaumont district of the DPS which takes in Tyler County.

If it is necessary for you to get out on the highways this weekend, drive carefully and defensively. Be defensive, we mean watch the other motorist and be in a position to take appropriate action to prevent an accident when necessary. Don't take chances—it matters very little who had the right-of-way after the accident happened.

Wick Fowler, newsmen and recently a war correspondent in Viet Nam, has launched a campaign to give the victims of a crime the same protection as the Supreme Court and state codes give the offender. With tongue in cheek, Fowler has come up with a proposed amendment to the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, as follows:

The constitutions of our state and nation as written (and as rewritten occasionally by the U. S. Supreme Court) have jealously guarded the rights of criminals of no name suspected of crime. Strict guidelines have evolved, such as:

1. No person can be requested or required to give a confession without first having his constitutional rights explained to him, he offered the services of an attorney and being warned of the consequences of any statement he gives.

2. Any person arrested must be taken immediately before a magistrate where he is to be warned and his constitutional rights explained him.

3. Any person arrested for a crime must be warned by some person other than the arresting officer and must be accorded an attorney every opportunity to secure the services of an attorney to represent him and explain his rights to him.

The granting of these restrictions is anchored on the foundation that a criminal suspect must from the very beginning be warned or advised of his rights and they must be explained to him and he must be accorded an opportunity to protect those rights.

What about the victim of a crime? Hope is building for the offender. There is now being studied as a prelude to preparation of legislation to establish equal rights for the offender.

It is being proposed that the new Code of Criminal Procedure in Texas be amended by the Legislature so as to require any person who plans, contemplates, promotes, or undertakes the commission of a crime against the person or property of another to first warn his victim of his intention and afford the victim a reasonable opportunity not only to be advised of his rights before the crime is committed but to take such steps as are reasonably necessary to defend against the crime. He should, and under such law would be given the opportunity to secure the services of an attorney, police officer or other person or persons before the criminal commits the crime in order that his constitutional rights be secure and his person and property not be violated.

It would be proposed that any criminal violating such law would be subject to a

penalty equivalent to the maximum penalty provided for the substantive crime committed. It would be contemplated that this would be a separate crime and an additional offense and in such cases, since we are dealing with basic constitutional rights, there would be no provision for parole for any violation of this act.

Tyler County commissioners, which has been sitting as a board of equalization off and on for the past few weeks, Monday voted to recess until the tax assessor, A. L. Thornton, prepares the tax roll, when they will meet again to approve it.

At the meeting Monday, the commissioners voted down a motion by Joe Best and seconded by Leon Fowler to raise the valuation on timber companies and utility firms. Best and Fowler voted for the motion and F. C. Hicks and H. W. Powell against. County judge Jeff Sweeney broke the tie by voting against the motion.

A motion by Powell and seconded by Hicks to let the tax rate stay the same as last year was approved, with Powell, Hicks and Mynning voting for and Best and Fowler against the motion.

WATER SYSTEM LOAN FOR CHESTER AREA IS APPROVED, WORK TO BEGIN

A \$128,800 loan to a group of 123 farm and rural families in Tyler County, Texas to develop a water system which has been closed the Farmers Home Administration reports.

The loan will enable the Chester Water Supply Corporation to develop a water system which will consist of a drilled well equipped with pump, a ground storage reservoir, hydro-pneumatic pressure system, lines, valves, and meters necessary to produce and distribute an adequate and safe supply of water for domestic and livestock use. The ground storage reservoir will have a capacity of 30,000 gallons.

The construction of the project will provide 2400 man-days of labor for engineers, well drillers, operators of ditch digging equipment, Friseman Pump Company of Jasper was low bidder on the system.

Some 20 people will be employed in the construction of the water system. The system will be capable of delivering 144,000 gallons a day when completed.

This system will improve the living conditions of approximately 400 people. Three churches and two schools will benefit.

Many families have shallow wells which do not furnish a dependable water supply.

The Farmers Home Administration loan is to be repaid over a period of 40 years.

Rural water system loans are available to organizations operating on a nonprofit basis, such as nonprofit corporations and water supply districts. Small rural towns and other rural political subdivisions are also eligible.

These loans are made only when adequate credit at reasonable rates and terms are not otherwise available.

Since January 1961, the Farmers Home Administration has made 315 loans to rural groups and small towns in Texas for a total of \$35,318,500.

According to recent tests made by the American Institute of Laundering, fitted bottom sheets with elastic sewn into the corners are longer than those fitted cotton sheets with non-elastic corners.

In the research tests, sheets with elastic corners were used for 52 weeks of wear and repair needed. Fitted sheets with non-elastic corners had to be repaired after only 21 weeks of use. Both types of sheets were of comparable quality materials.

The fitted bottom sheets usually do not last nearly as long as flat sheets which can be rotated to distribute the wear more evenly.

Other factors to consider when shopping for sheets are the variety of finishes of fabric in which they are made.
