Open House Friday To Show Waste Treatment Plant

The largest waste-water treatment plant ever built in central East Texas will be unveiled by Southland Paper Mills, Inc., in Lufkin Friday, Southland President H. W. Wortham, Jr., said the public is invited to inspect the \$25-million facility during an open house at 2 p.m.

The plant is located on the right bank of the Anglin River, just east of Lufkin on Texas Highway 193. It will be the largest of its kind in the state and one of the largest in the world.

The plant consists of five concrete aeration basins, two circular primary clarifiers, a rectangular aeration basin, and two circular final clarifiers. Each covers an acre.

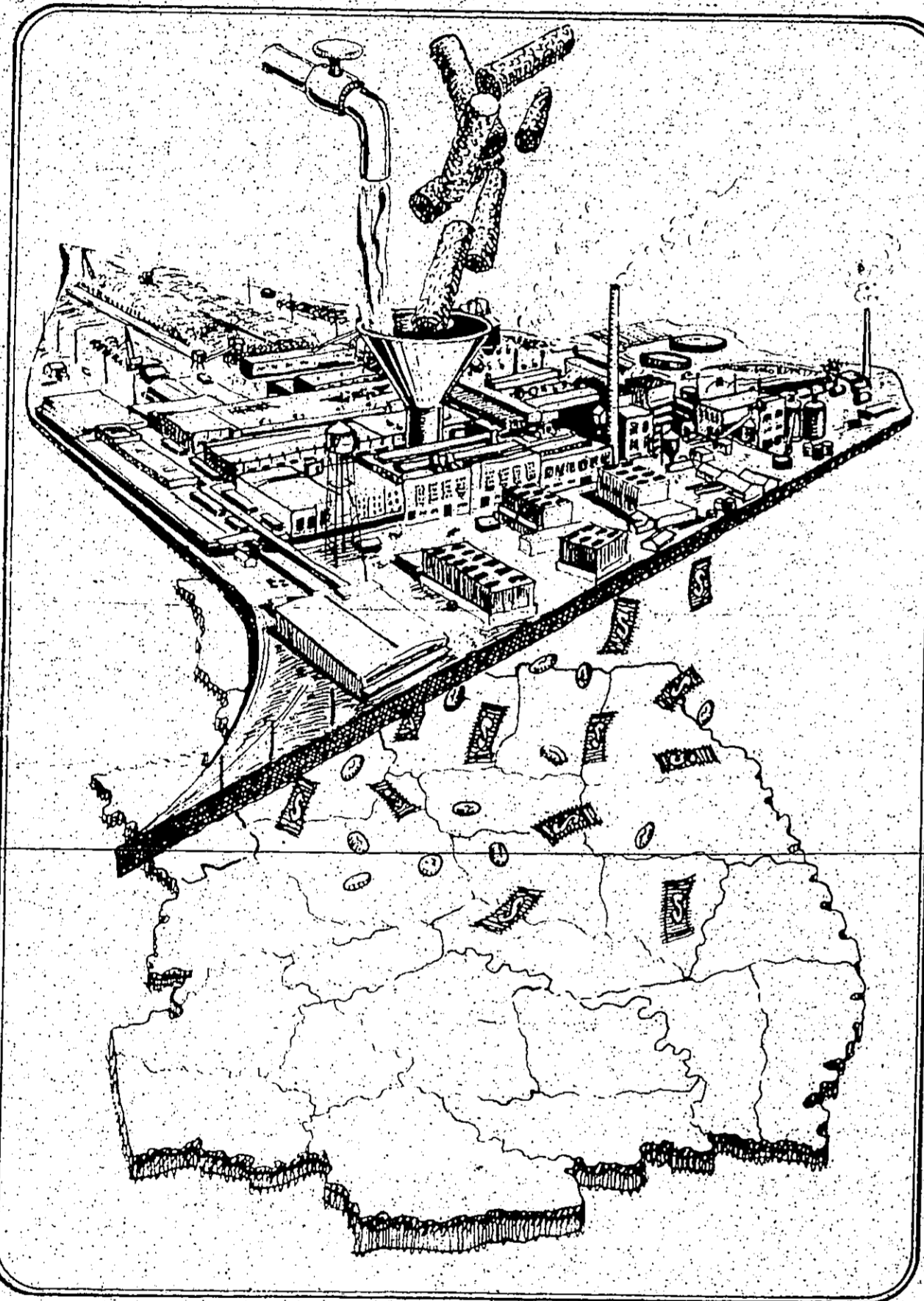
Other features include ten 60-horsepower aerators that inject oxygen into the water to implement a biological treating process and a two-mile concrete canal designed to help the water absorb additional oxygen from the air.

The plant, which will be put into operation during the week-end after it has been viewed by the public, was specifically designed and built for Southland to take advantage of the latest research discoveries in the field of waste-water treatment.

The plant will utilize a "triple" treatment process, already in use at Southland's Lufkin mill, which includes a primary clarifier, a secondary clarifier, and a tertiary clarifier. The tertiary clarifier will remove suspended solids and other impurities from the water before it is discharged into the Anglin River.

"We are proud to have this plant," Wortham said. "It is a practical way to solve the water pollution problem in the Lufkin area."

WATER & SOUTHLAND



Water + Wood + Southland = \$18 Million Annually

In early 1940, the first roll of newsprint made from Southern pine trees rolled off the production line of a new plant near Lufkin.

It was the beginning of Southland Paper Mills, Inc.

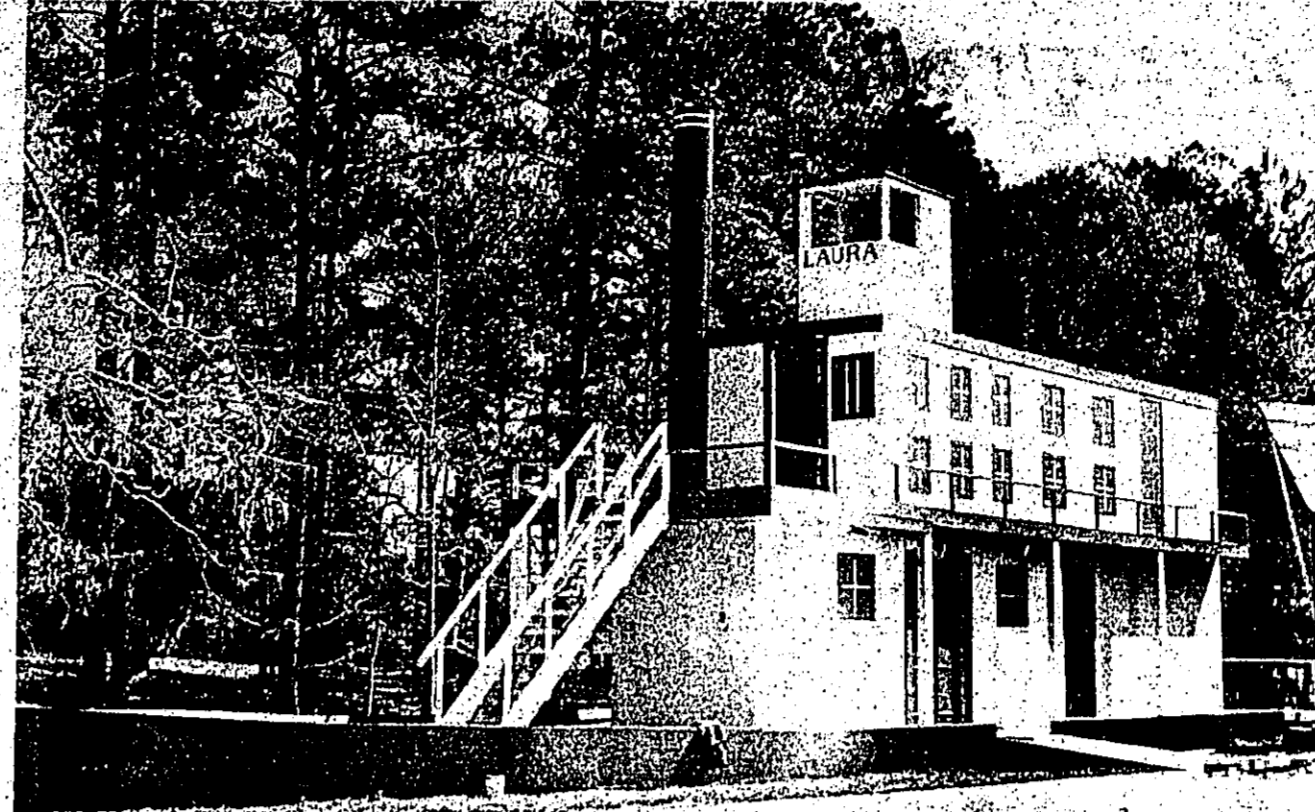
