Industrial Class At KHS Completes Year

Kirby High School's Vocational Cooperative Training class has completed its first year with an excellent record and has six winners in contests on the district and state level.

Industrial cooperative training is a program under the State Education Agency similar to the Future Farmers or Future Homemakers except that students are trained in skilled occupations through the cooperation of local businesses and industries, which pay the student for on-the-job training.

Class members have a regular class schedule for academic studies and then receive on-the-job training for three hours at the sponsoring business or industry. They also have a one-hour classroom session in related technical studies on their chosen occupation.

Statewide there are over 50 approved skilled occupations in which students may receive training. However, in a small town such as Woodville the number of businesses or industries in which such training may be received is considerably fewer.

There are 21 students enrolled in the class at Kirby High school and they are receiving training in 13 different skilled occupations. Six of these competed in the district contests at Bryan and four qualified to go to the State contest in Houston. Two of them received awards. They are Ruby Skinner, who received first for her Nurse Aide Notebook, and Sadler Celestine, who was second in oxy-acetylene welding. In the contests, students from small schools are in competition with those from large schools and competition is on an individual basis.

A number of students are shown receiving on-the-job training in the accompanying photos. Jack Risinger, advisor to the class, says that the excellent record the class has made in its first year is a good indication for the need of such a program and expects a larger enrollment next year.

Daylight Saving Time Monday

Congress passed a law, as they are always doing, setting Daylight Saving Time as the standard across the country beginning May 1 and running through the summer months. States which did not pass a bill expressly exempting their citizens from the Daylight Saving Time act must abide by the new law, and the Texas legislature did not get a bill through exempting the state.

And when (yawn) you come to work Monday at 7 p.m. Daylight Saving Time, don't turn your eyes to the east and gaze at the sun. It'll be in the same place it was at 6 p.m. Sunday, give or take a minute or two.

Travel 8 miles on FM 1943 east from Warren and turn left on county dirt road and travel about 2 miles to the farm.

Dr. Neal Pratt, pasture specialist and Wayne Taylor, area farm management specialist, both from Texas A & M University, will be the guest speakers. This is an opportunity to observe an operation that is producing 550 pound calves from mother cows at seven months of age on less than two acres per animal unit and has excess hay to sell, county agent Clifton Currie said.
