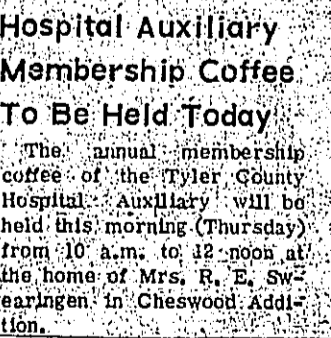
## Red Cross Again To Send Gift Bags To Boys In Vietnam

The American National Red Cross project to send gift bags for distribution to Christmas to servicemen in Vietnam will be repeated by the Tyler county chapter again this year.

The quota for the area which includes Southeast Texas is 160,000 filled gift bags. Volunteer workers will make the bags out of heavy denim with red and green drawstrings, according to Vicki Warfield, home service officer for the Tyler county chapter.

The public is urged to assist in the project. Items permissible for the bags include a large number of small useful articles, and all should be new. Suggested articles include ball point pens, paperback books of all kinds, plastic soap cases, small packages of writing paper with self-seal envelopes, small address books, wash cloths, tooth paste, plastic tooth brush holders, nail clippers, combs, plastic cigarette cases, small games which can be carried in pocket such as checkers, dominoes, or playing cards, chess sets and pinole, malling size voice tapes, small tins of nuts or candies (vacuum packed), wipe and shine shoe polish, foot powder, etc.
