



# STATE CAPITOL HIGHLIGHTS & SIDELIGHTS

Arrival at the mill-way mark in the 3-day special legislative session touched off an explosion of activity in key areas of spending, taxation and other by-the-drink.

Both House and Senate passed versions of the 1969 budget and went to conference committee to work out differences.

House passed by a narrow margin (78 votes to 67) Gov. John Connally's bill to permit deposit by the bank in a multi-million dollar tax reduction and state repudiation.

House Revenue and Tax Committee sent out for debate and full House action Connally's \$119 million tax package. This committee measure hopefully will be carried to the floor this week after amendments in both houses.

Representatives voted overwhelmingly for a \$474 million general revenue budget, senators for a \$477 million general fund appropriation bill.

House version would require \$132 million in new revenue, Senate bill \$137 million. All phases of the legislation have been assigned to House and Senate committees.

House fought a bitter battle over the multi-million dollar bill. Majority on both sides proposed Senate to split by one vote in the House. Poll takers said 101 senators would vote in favor of the bill.

A sales tax increase to the 7.5 per cent level was the key to the bill's passage. This measure the legislature voted a straight table vote of 75-75 per cent of the vote.

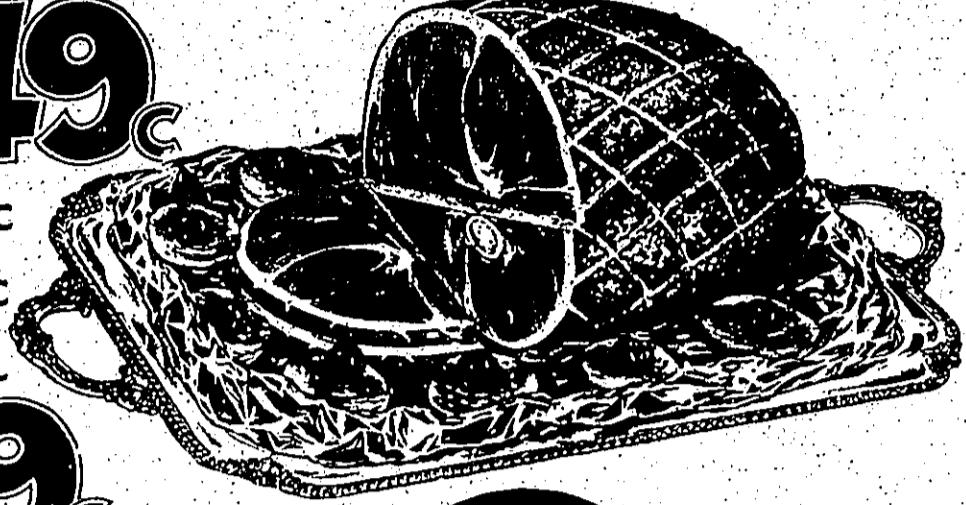
