WEAVING DEMONSTRATION TO BE FEATURED AT HERITAGE GARDEN

Mrs. Ruth White, nationally known weaver and holder of many national awards, will demonstrate weaving on a primitive loom at Heritage Garden Museum during Dogwood Festival day, April 5.

Mrs. White will set up her loom on the front porch of the old Tolar cabin, 102-year-old state historical medallion home. The loom on which she will be weaving is similar to ones used thousands of years ago and are still used by primitive tribes where civilization has not reached. The wood for the loom, Mrs. White explained, came from the Big Thicket and are sticks of yupon.

On the split rail fence by the cabin, Mrs. White will have "fairing", a family heirloom, a covert handwoven on a sixteen harness loom more than a hundred years ago. She will display also a few other items such as a pioneer woman might have woven from materials available—rag rugs, pine needle place mats, wall hangings with Spanish moss, honeysuckle and magnolia leaves. John Dowdy To Crown Festival Queen

The queen's coronation and the pageant which will follow Saturday night will again be attended by an overflowing crowd in the 3500-seat Dogwood Amphitheatre at the school campus.

The coronation ceremonies will begin at 7:00 p.m. and will feature the introduction of 34 duchesses and escorts representing cities outside Tyler County, the coronation of the king and the crowning of the 1969 queen by U. S. Rep. John Dowdy. The 1969 queen will succeed Deil Jordan of Spurger, who will make her farewell appearance prior to the introduction of the princesses and escorts representing Tyler County towns. The new queen has already been chosen by the King's Men but her identity will not be revealed until the coronation ceremonies.

Princesses from among whom the queen was chosen are Debbie Davis of Woodville, Stella Allen of Colmesnell, Debbie Hooks of Surger and Kay Owens of Warren. All are high school seniors except Miss Hooks, who is a junior at Spurger High School. The runner-up will be Princess of Tyler County and the other two princesses from their respective towns.

Each princess will have an escort, and one of these will be crowned king—depending on who is queen. Escorts are Ben Stewart, Jr. for Miss Allen, James Odum for Miss Hooks, Jesse Ray for Miss Owens, and Dan Utley for Miss Davis.

Crown bearer for the king is Brown Mott of Colmesnell. Kendall Barnes of Chester will be the ring bearer, and Keith Reese of Warren is the queen's crown bearer. Nancy Polk of Woodville and Melinda Hooks of Spurger are flower girls. Trainbearers are Lolita Payne, Juanita Hooks, Lynne Shutter, Barbara Clark and Karen Gilchrist.

Organ music and coronation music will be by Dr. James Jimette of Woodville and Jason Summers of Nacogdoches. Mrs. Melvin D. Houston will sing "Trees" in the prelude to the coronation.

Dr. Arleigh Templeton, president of Sam Houston State College, will be presented the Mr. East Texas award by Master of Ceremonies Josiah Wheat.

Following the colorful coronation ceremonies the traditional historical pageant will be presented on the huge stage of the amphitheatre.

A Word From Texas Bishops On Liquor-By-The-Drink

We, the undersigned Bishops of the United Methodist Church in Texas, wish to make the following joint statement relative to the two bills now in the Texas Legislature, SB 810 and HB 12, relating to liquor-by-the-drink.

First of all, we are concerned for the health and welfare of our state in the matter of alcohol consumption. Experience has shown that states which have bottle sales only of distilled spirits to liquor-by-the-drink have had a tremendous increase in the per capita consumption of alcoholic beverages.

Secondly, we are concerned about the rising number of alcoholics in our nation. Experience has shown and research proves that states which have bottle sales only (note Washington state as example only) the rate of alcoholism increased sharply within a short time.

Thirdly, we are concerned with the ever-increasing problem of highway safety in our land. The number of deaths on the highways of states that have gone from package store sales to LIQUOR-BY-THE-DRINK has increased far more rapidly than in the states that continued to have package stores only.

Fourthly, we are concerned for the welfare of youth in our state. It is conservatively estimated that at least 15,000 additional outlets will come to our state shortly under LIQUOR-BY-THE-DRINK. Youth will be faced with the consumption of alcohol on every hand and many of them will begin consuming earlier and to a larger degree than if it were not so prominent in our midst.

Fifthly, we are concerned for the welfare of our state. It is conservatively estimated that at least 15,000 additional outlets will come to our state shortly under LIQUOR-BY-THE-DRINK. Youth will be faced with the consumption of alcohol on every hand and many of them will begin consuming earlier and to a larger degree than if it were not so prominent in our midst.
