Coronary-artery blockage is the main cause in the new concept in which the heart is attacked by blockage in the coronary arteries.

More than half the deaths from heart attacks occur within the first 24 hours, according to Dr. Paul N. Yu, professor of medicine and head of the cardiology unit at the University of Rochester School of Medicine. Half of these deaths are unattended by medical personnel.

The most coronary artery disease is found in people who have high blood pressure, are obese, are smokers, and have a family history of the disease.

There are ambulance equipped with up-to-date facilities for diagnosis and management of an irregular heart beat which can cause death and for other complications. Dr. Yu says the preliminary results have been encouraging and promising.

About 1,500 hospital beds are taken, Post having water in the country now have the cure. Just two years ago there were 400 units. Patients have had the survival rate by about 30% following heart attacks.

Spair Urges Early Inspection Of Motor Vehicles

With the State's April 15 motor vehicle inspection deadline approximately 90 days away, large numbers of Texas motorists may never take their vehicles in for the mandatory annual safety inspection.

Gordon Wilson, Sr., Spair, director of the Texas Department of Public Safety, this week urged all motorists whose vehicles have not been inspected as soon as possible.

Mr. Wilson said, "The greatest danger to the public is not that the vehicles will not be inspected but that they will be inspected in a haphazard manner by inspectors who are not properly trained or equipped to do the job."

Mr. Wilson said that the current inspection program in Texas is the most comprehensive and effective in the nation.

Registration Of Aliens Due By End Of January

F. DeWitt Marshall, director of the Immigration and Naturalization Service, today urged all aliens in this area who have not yet filed out alien address reports to do so before January 31 at the nearest Immigration and Naturalization Service office or local post office.

The Immigration office pointed out that the law requires all non-citizens, except persons in diplomatic status and foreign representatives to certain international organizations, such as the United Nations, to report their addresses to the Government each January.

Mr. Marshall added, "The parent of legal guardian of an alien child under 14 years of age must fill out the address report form for such a child in order to comply with the law."

IRS Does Not Accept Credit Cards For Income Tax Payment

The Internal Revenue Service announced that it has not entered into any arrangements with banks or others for the payment of taxes by credit card.

It means that you must pay income tax in full by check or cash.

R. L. Phinney, district director of Internal Revenue for southern Texas, said the IRS will not accept credit cards and that any credit arrangement for the payment of Federal taxes is strictly between the taxpayer and his bank or other credit company. On the other hand, if a check or other document issued by a bank or credit company is used by a taxpayer in payment of taxes, it is acceptable by the Federal Reserve District concerned as a negotiable instrument for banking purposes, it will be accepted by the IRS. However, if a check or similar instrument is not honored by the bank on which it is drawn, the taxpayer may be subject to penalties.

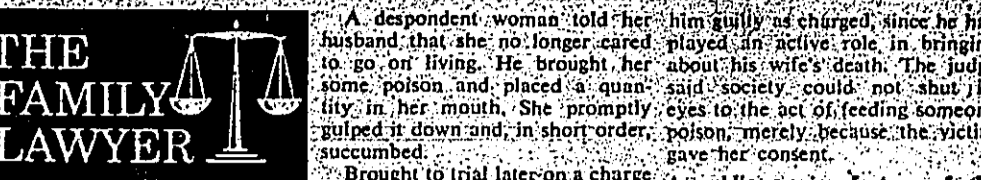

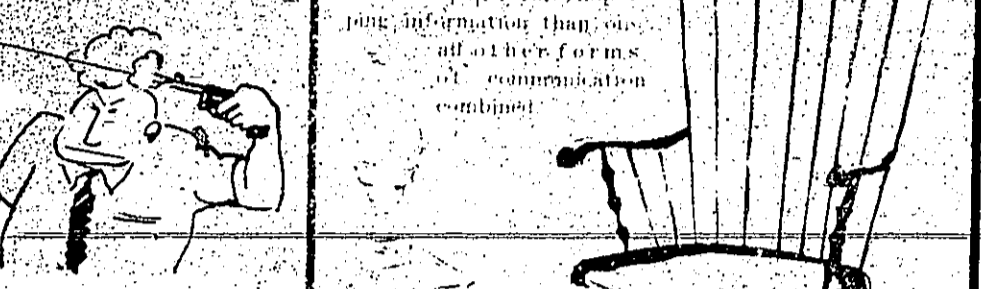
