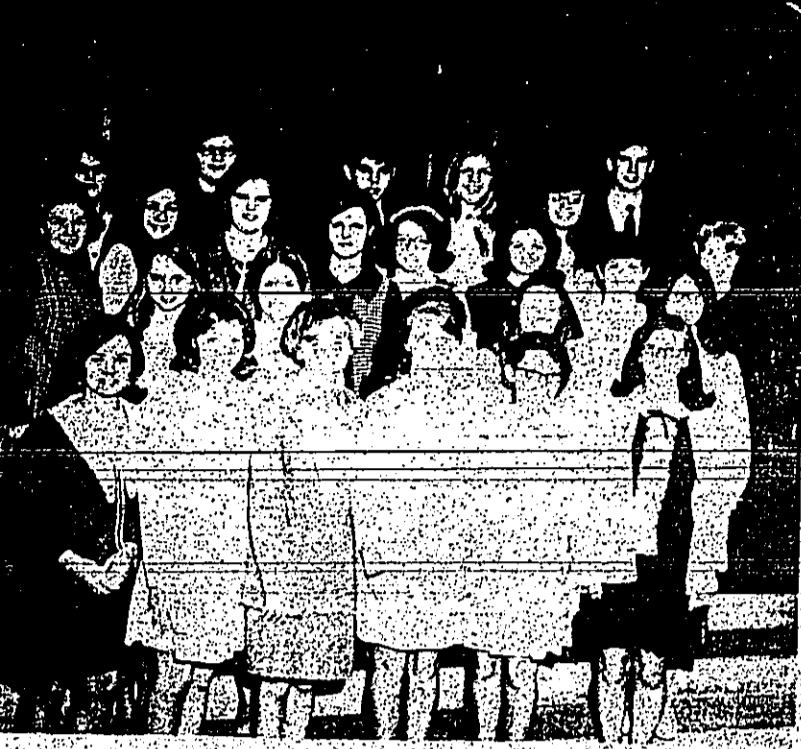
Art Green, district forester for district 4 located in Woodville, said that because of the high winds and low humidity five to eight fires have been reported some days.

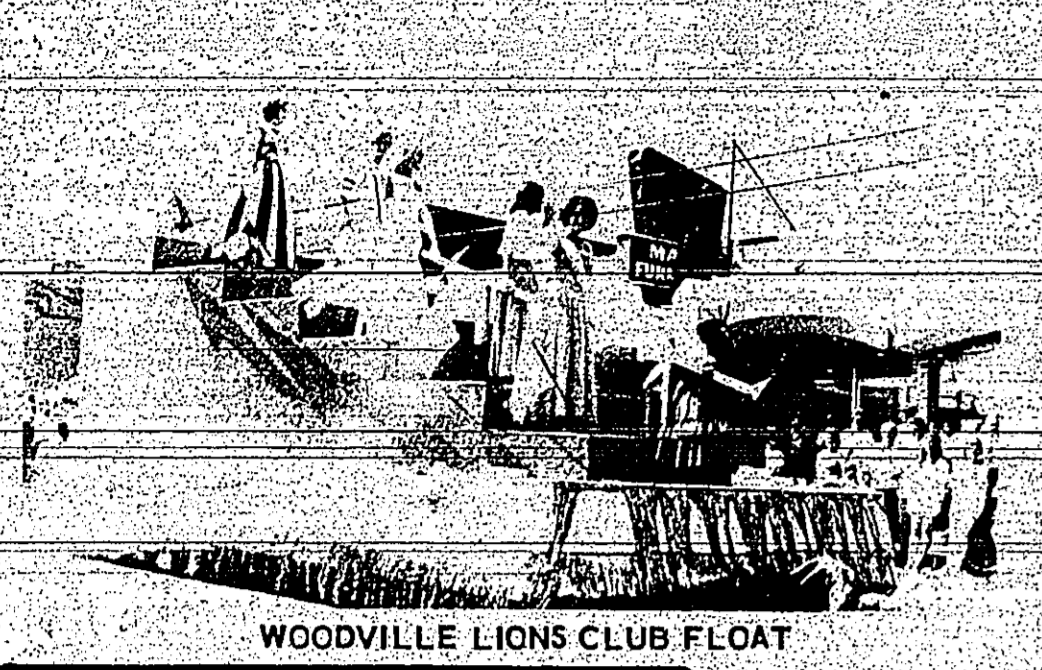

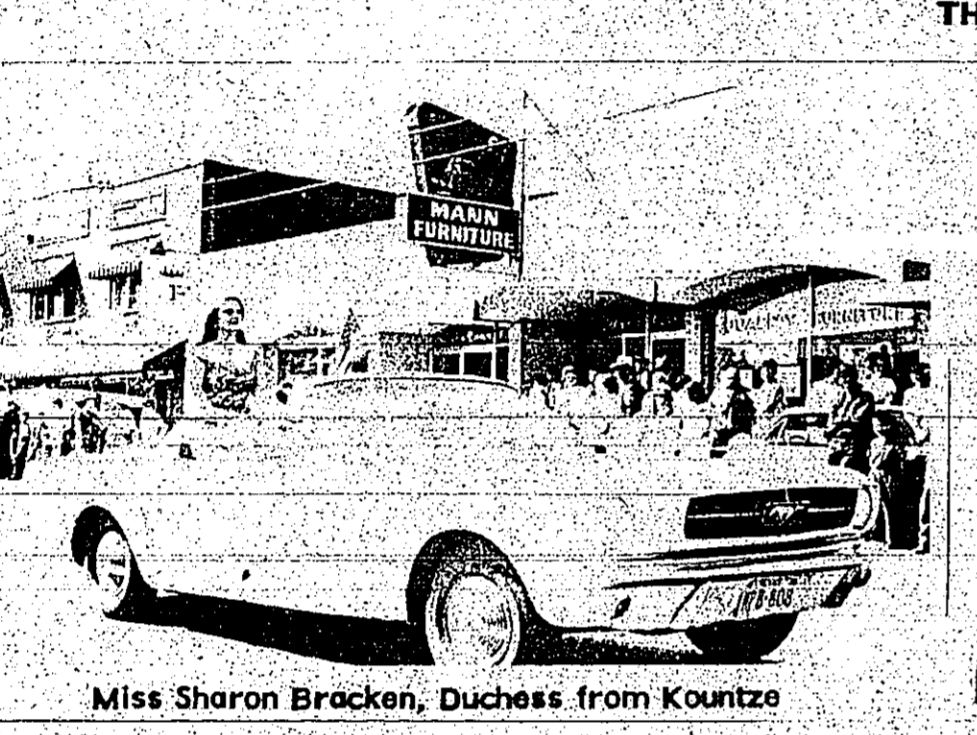

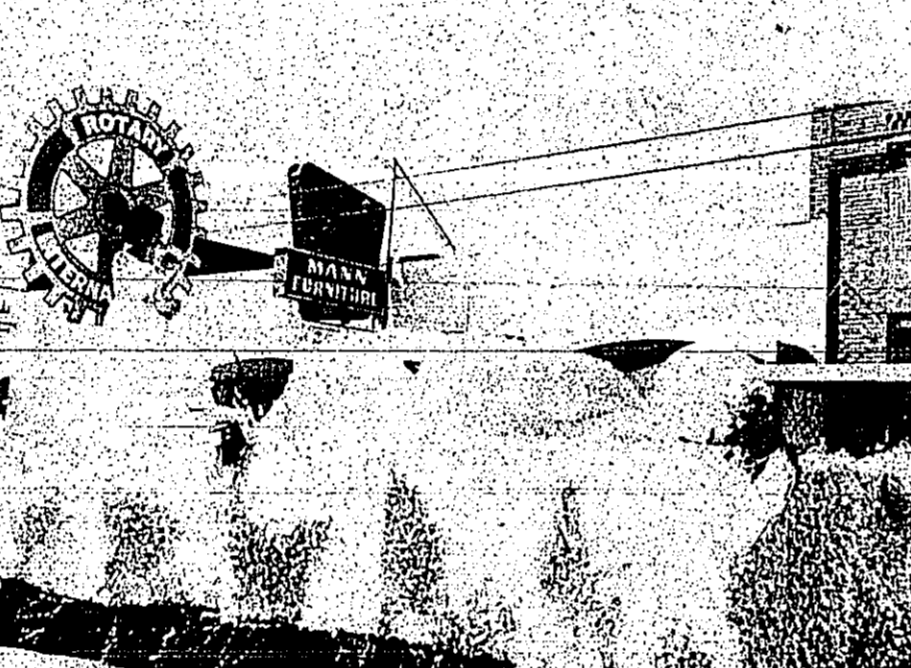
