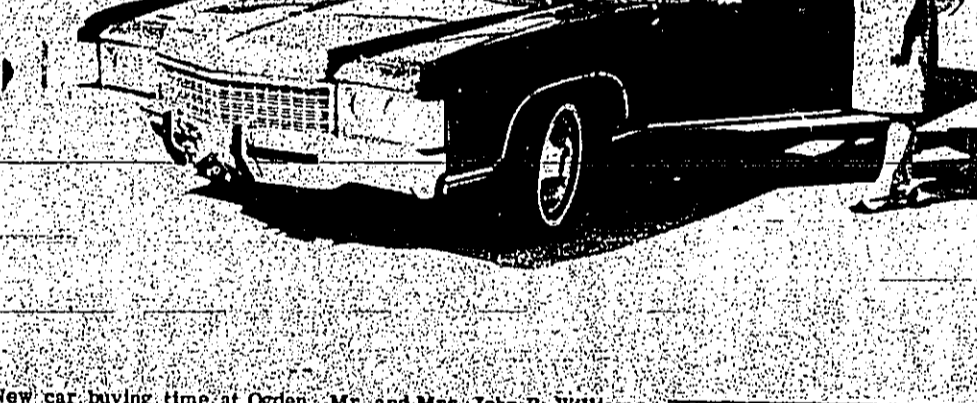

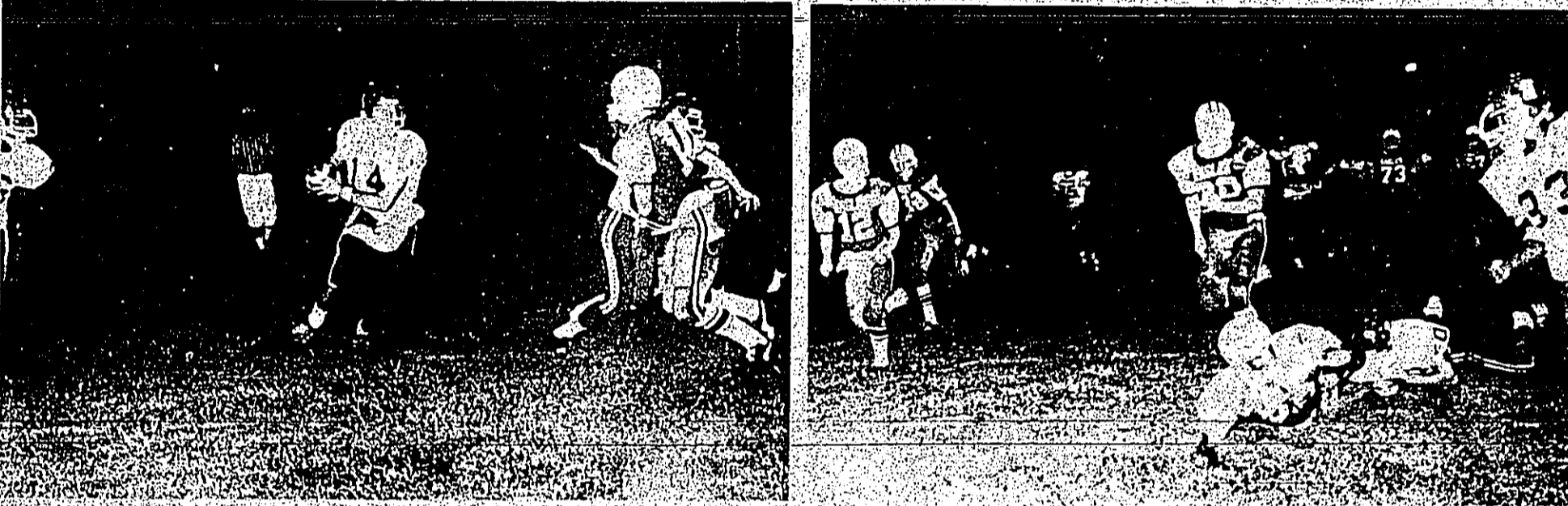
CHESTER MAINTAINS LOOP LEAD ; WIN 28-0

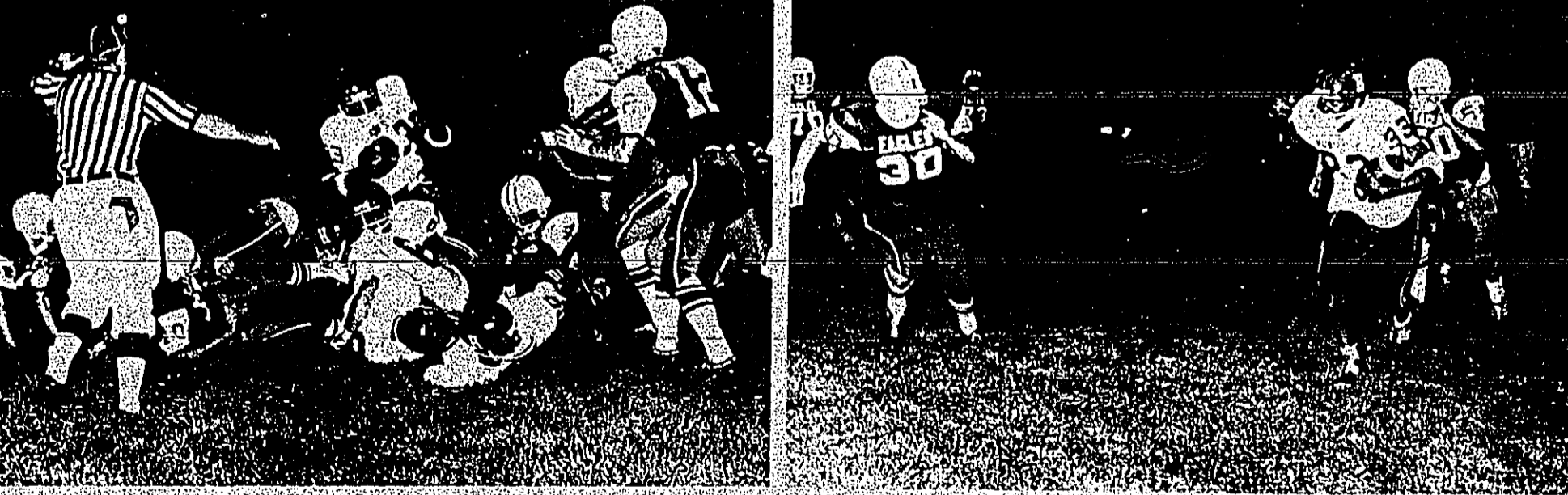
