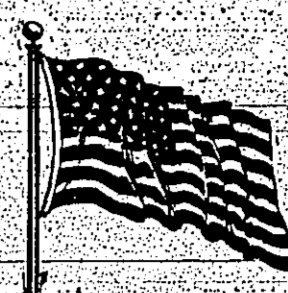

## Rites Held Tuesday For Judge Smith

Funeral services for Clyde E. Smith, Sr., 73, retired associate justice of the Texas Supreme Court and lifelong prominent Woodville attorney, were held at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday in the First Baptist Church.

Justice Smith died Saturday night from a heart attack he had suffered Friday in Columbus while enroute from Austin to Houston to attend the 100th anniversary banquet of the Houston Bar Association.

He had left Austin Friday morning and at Columbus drove into a service station where he told the operator he thought he was having a heart attack. The station operator closed the station and drove Justice Smith to a hospital.

He died suddenly before midnight Saturday night. The family had talked with the doctor several times during the day and Justice Smith apparently was recuperating excellently.

Justice Smith retired from the Texas Supreme Court at the end of last December. He resigned to devote some time to work toward reforming the state court system.

He had served as county attorney of Tyler County and three terms as district attorney of the 75th judicial district. He was appointed to the State Supreme Court by then-Governor Shivers.

He had served continuously since that time. At the time of his retirement Associate Justice Jack Pope said that Judge Smith had written just under 400 opinions, about one-third of them dissenting, which meant extra work for him.

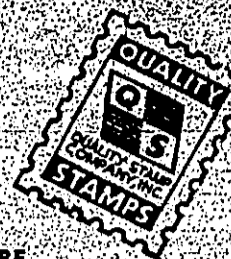

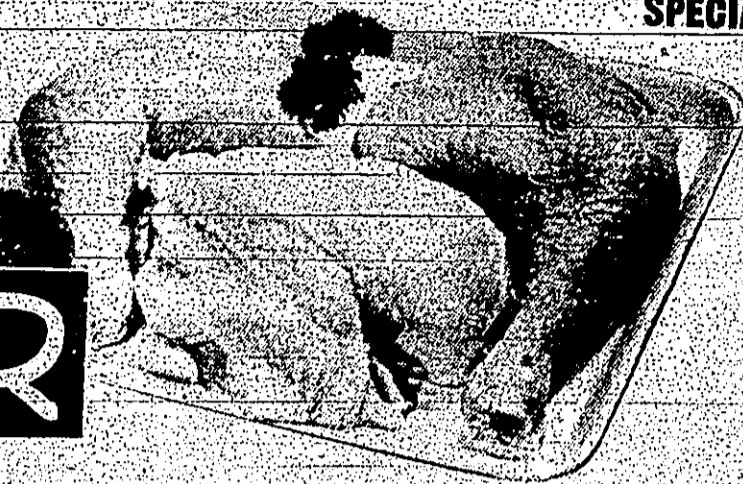

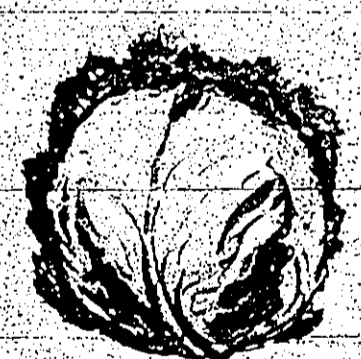
