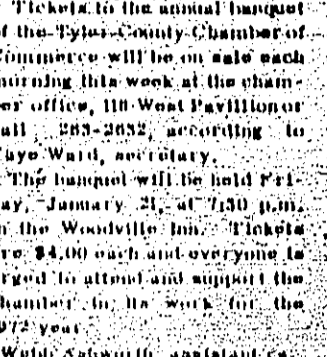

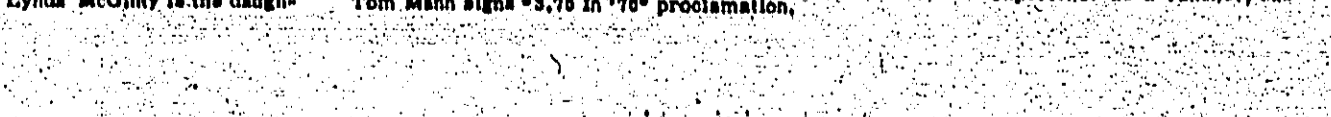

Employers of Household Workers Must Send in Social Security Contributions

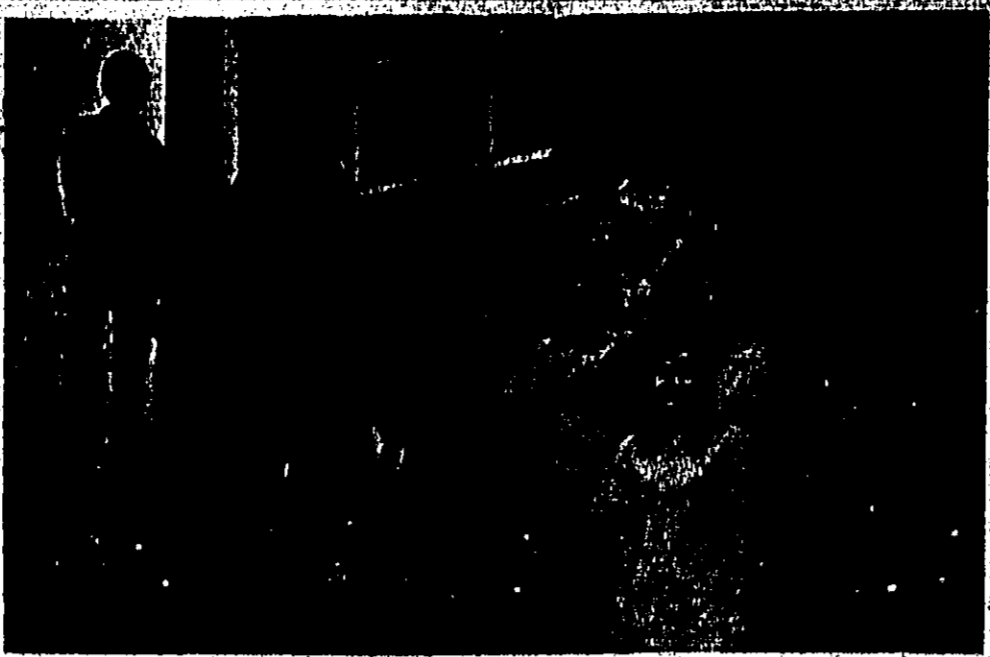
People who employ household workers have an important job to do themselves this month, according to social security officials here.

Those who employ a household worker covered by social security, you're required to send a wage report and social security contributions to the Internal Revenue Service by January 31, a social security spokesman said.

The wage report and the social security contributions are for the last quarter of 1972.

You're required to report the spokesman said, "if you employ a household worker, but in some cases wages in any 3-month period.

January 31 is the deadline for employers to send in their reports, the spokesman said.
