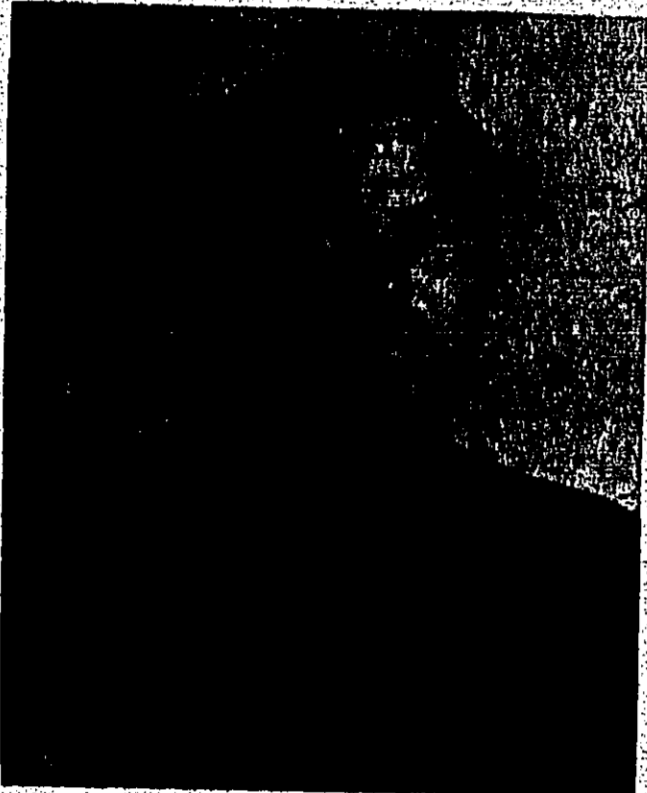

Woman Shot To Death

A 16-year-old Negro woman was shot to death about midnight Friday in what officers say was a family quarrel. Betty Jean Clements was shot once through the chest with a .24 caliber pistol. McKinley Barclay, 27, told officers that he and the girl were arguing for possession of the pistol during a quarrel and that the girl accidentally discharged it. The shooting took place in Barclay's home in the Barclay settlement near Hilldale. A 10-year-old boy was asleep in the house at the time but did not awaken him, officers were told. Barclay was freed on bond pending a study of the evidence by the grand jury, according to Deputy Sheriff D. J. Vandeman.

Banks To Close For Washington's Birthday Monday

All banks in Texas will be closed Monday in observance of the birthday of George Washington, father of our country. This will affect the three banks in Tyler County—Citizens State Bank, Chester State Bank and First State Bank of Colmesneil. In accordance with recently passed legislation Texas banks will observe holidays on nine working days during the year.

Dogwood Tickets To Go On Sale At Business Places

Tickets to the 1972 Tyler County Dogwood Festival concert and pageant are now in the hands of Dick Davis who will have them distributed at various business places for sale within a week or less. In order to get good seating for family, friends and visitors the public is asked to buy tickets early. All seats are reserved.

Easter this year falls on April 7 which is the Sunday following the first Saturday of the Tyler County Dogwood Festival. In 1976, Easter will fall on March 30 which will be the Sunday following the Western Weekend of the festival.

The next year in which Easter and the festival activities will fall on the same weekend will be in 1978 when Easter comes on March 26.

The festival is set for the last Saturday in March and the first Saturday in April since those are the weekends during which the dogwood is usually in full bloom. The fact that in some years Easter falls on the following Sunday is no way nullifying the festival. In getting tickets for the parade on the first Saturday in April at high school and in those listed for the parade, the parade program, pageant, and concert, usually observe a holiday period for 1972.

Since Easter falls on an odd day, March 22 and 23 late in April, the parade will be held on the first Saturday in April for the convenience and school schedule. It probably will be held about 10 a.m. as well as any other date when the dogwood is in bloom.

Easter, which commemorates Christ's resurrection, is the first Sunday after the first full moon that falls on or next to the vernal equinox. If the full moon happens on Sunday, Easter is observed on week days. Dates on which Easter will fall during the next 16 years (after 1972) are: April 22, 1973; April 14, 1974; April 29, 1975; April 10, 1976; April 16, 1977; March 28, 1978; April 15, 1979; April 8, 1980; April 14, 1981; April 11, 1982; April 7, 1983; April 23, 1984; April 7, 1985; May 6, 1986; April 11, 1987.

And if you happen to be around in the year 2000, you can still see your Easter holiday on April 25. By the way, the earliest Easter in the 20th century was March 23, 1918, and the latest Easter in the century was April 25, 1943.

DECA Students Attend Contests

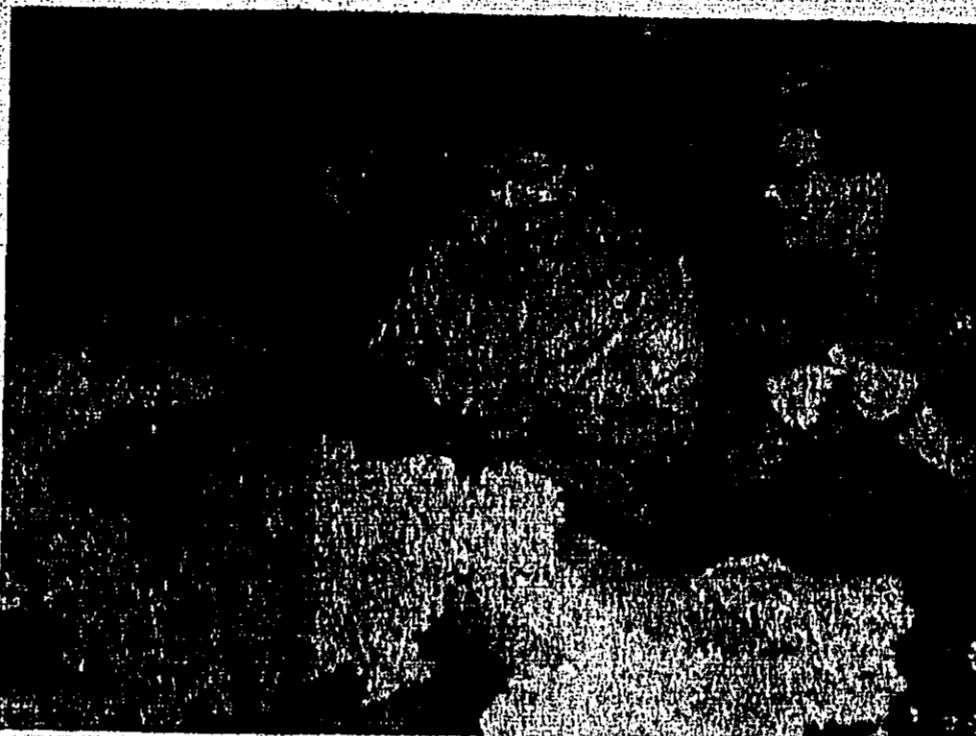


This group of Distributive Education students from Kirby High School recently attended the DECA Area III contest at Spring Branch.

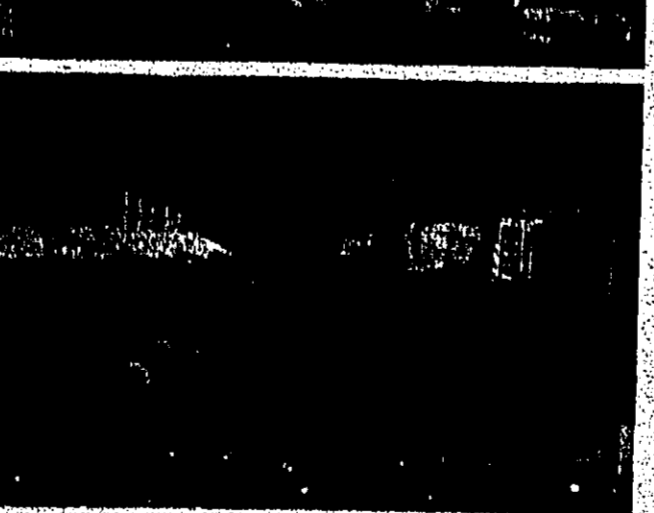
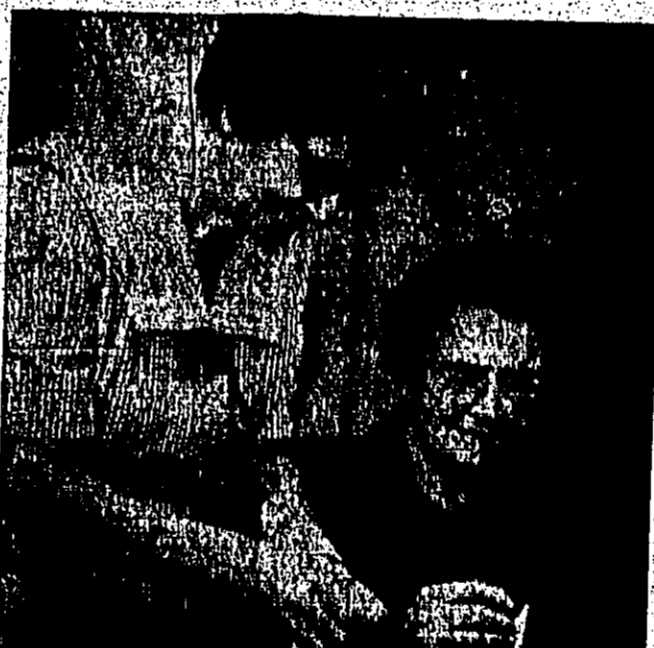
