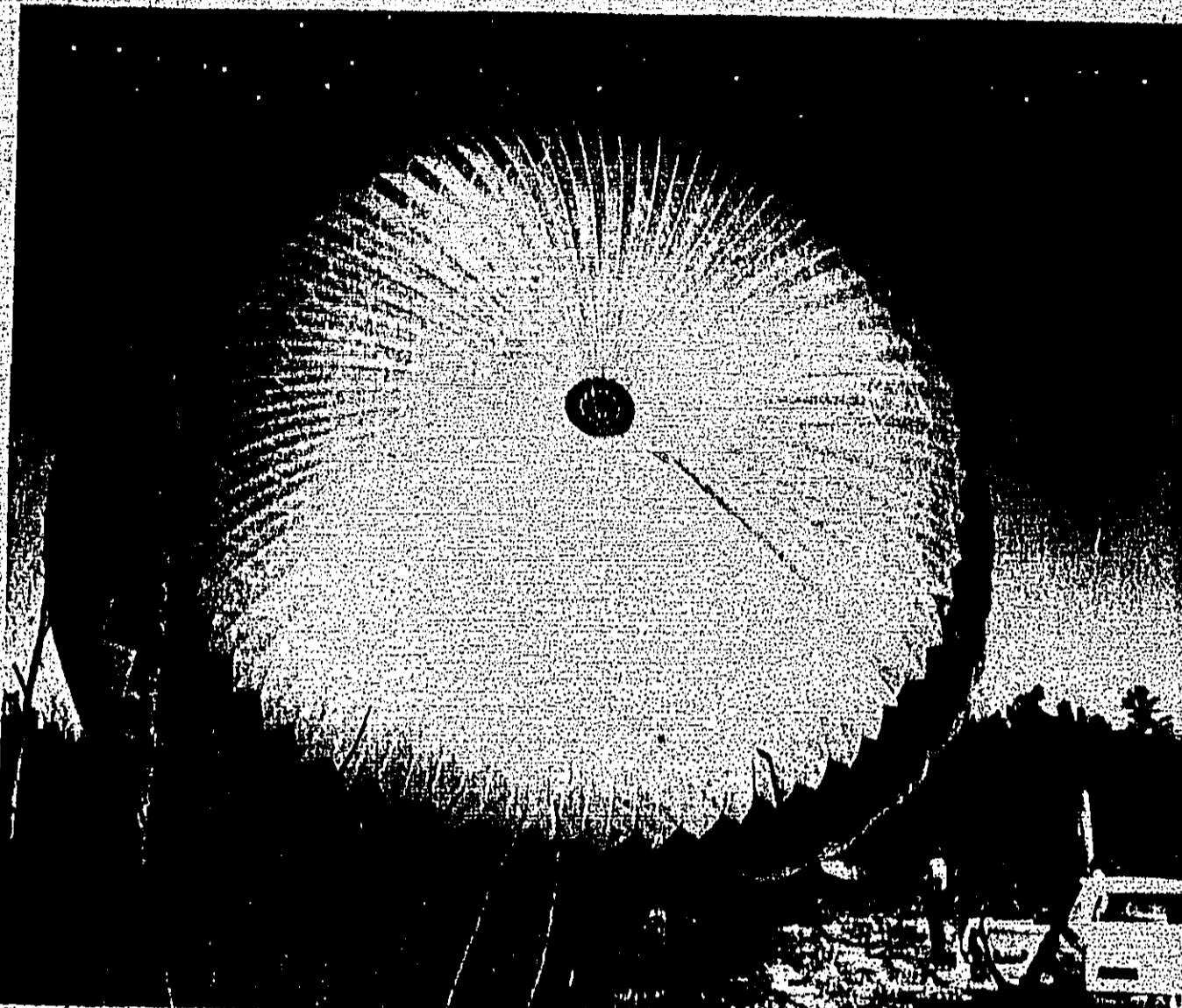

Instruments from a barated weather balloon lifted at Palestine Friday were parachuted to the ground about seven miles east of Woodville, Texas, after a clear day of flying.

Deputy Sheriff B. J. Vancovich said that he was told that the balloon was supposed to rise to 100,000 feet with instruments to measure intensity of gamma rays in the ionosphere. However, the balloon burst at 60,000 feet and as it came down the parachute and instruments were automatically deployed and the parachute opened to give the instrument package a relatively soft landing. Just below the instruments was a cylindrical buffer approximately four feet in diameter and about ten feet long, with soft plastic material on the bottom which absorbed most of the shock of landing.

Technicians from the federal weather station at Palestine picked up the instruments and parachute Saturday. The balloon came down in east of Tyler County. Vancovich said the technicians told him that the entire package—balloon, parachute, and instruments—cost about \$250,000 to assemble. The parachute is shown in the picture below as it was deflated.

Richard Galbreath Files For Position On School Board

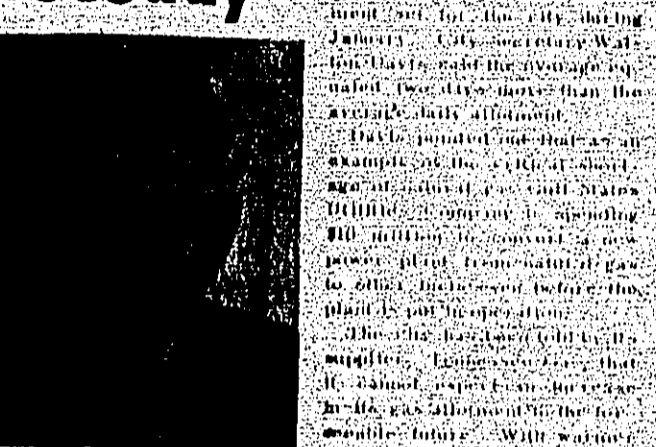
