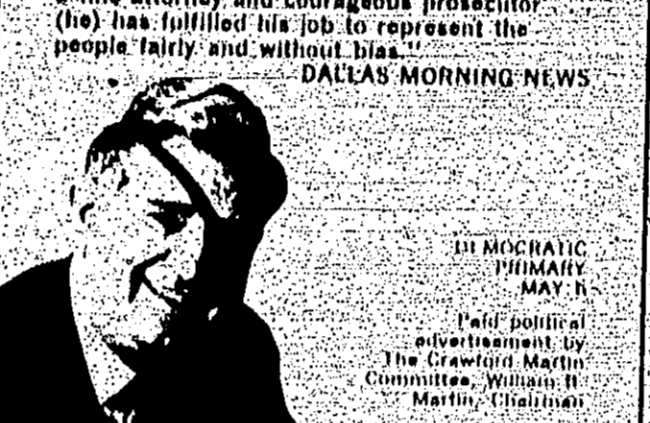

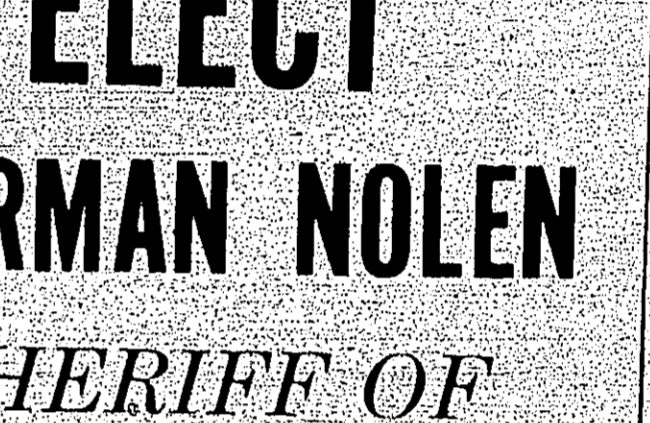

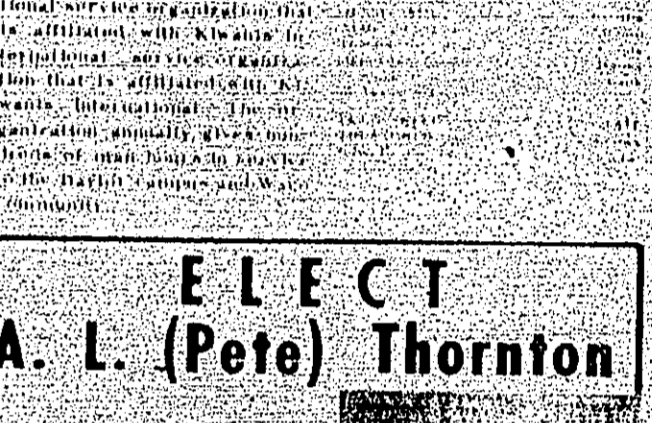

## We need the Wilsons in Washington

During his years in Austin, he has sponsored every single bill regarding our business as well as free (Blue Cross) medical insurance for the elderly.
