**Red Cross Drive Raises Over \$2800**  
Present tallying indicates Tyler County residents have contributed over \$2800 to the American Cancer Crusade, according to Mrs. Richard Cordes, county crusade chairman.

To date, the collection breakdown reveals Woodville residents have given \$788.47 and other county residents have given \$203.52. Individually, women and communities have given: Chester \$16.00; Colman \$287.87; Coonaker \$8.00; Fred \$10.00; Miller \$55.87; Ivanhoe \$81.00; Lake Hyatt \$22.87; Spurger \$165.88; and Warren \$140.00.

Woodville schools have given a total of \$10,76 with the total elementary \$66.16; junior high \$20.07; and senior high \$27.37.

The other schools have given a total of \$99.43 with Chester \$7.08; Colman \$13.41; Fred \$6.79; Spurger \$21.05; and Warren \$27.84.

Memorials have surpassed the \$400.00 mark. Woodville business have given over \$44.50.

These funds have been transferred to Austin, to the state treasurer of the American Cancer Society. The money will be utilized immediately to finance continued research in bridging the survival gap. Effective controls must be discovered to eliminate cancer.

Approximately 65 volunteers aided in the distribution of 3,000 life-saving pamphlets listing cancer's seven warning signals throughout Tyler County. Mrs. Cordes said she wanted to express special thanks to all the volunteers and participants who helped make this Cancer Crusade so successful.

Tyler County's solid waste disposal problem is being solved by a new landfill project which is nearly ready to begin.

The project, located on the east side of the county, has been approved by the Texas State Board of Health and the Texas State Board of Sanitation. The project will be completed by the end of the year.
