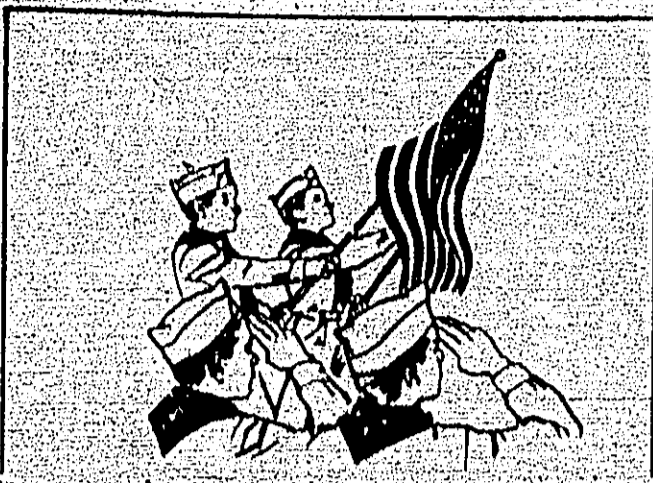

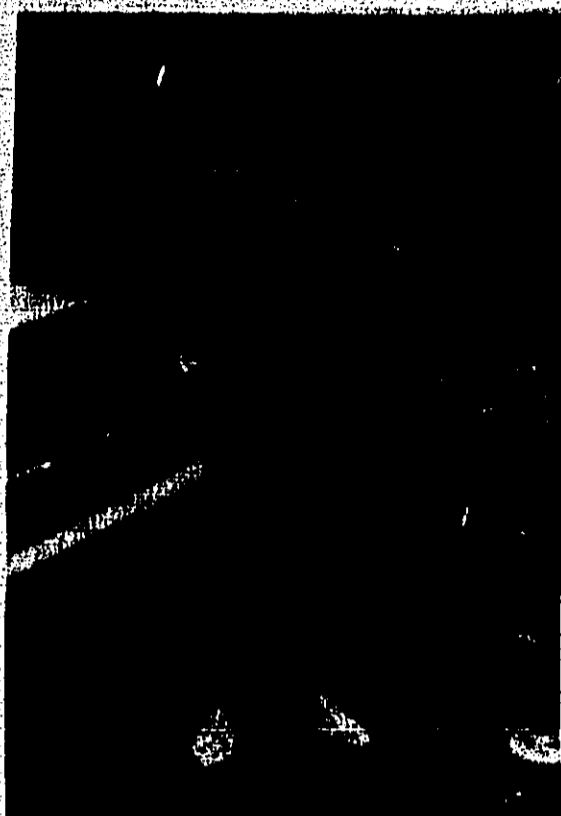
(Mr. Brown is a sociologist with the Texas A&M Extension Service.)

Woodville voters are in doubt today (Thursday) on the issue of \$100,000 in revenue bonds for the expansion of the sanitary sewer system. The city will be cast at the city hall with the polls open from 8 a. m. till 7 p. m. J. Wood's 1972 election judge and Neil Miller is alternate. If the revenue bonds are passed, it will enable the city to extend service to residents of Cook, Mill, Rowdy, the South Beach, West area, Livingston, White, Cook, Livingston, highway, Cawood, addition, Highway 201, North Dallas Street and Highway 101. 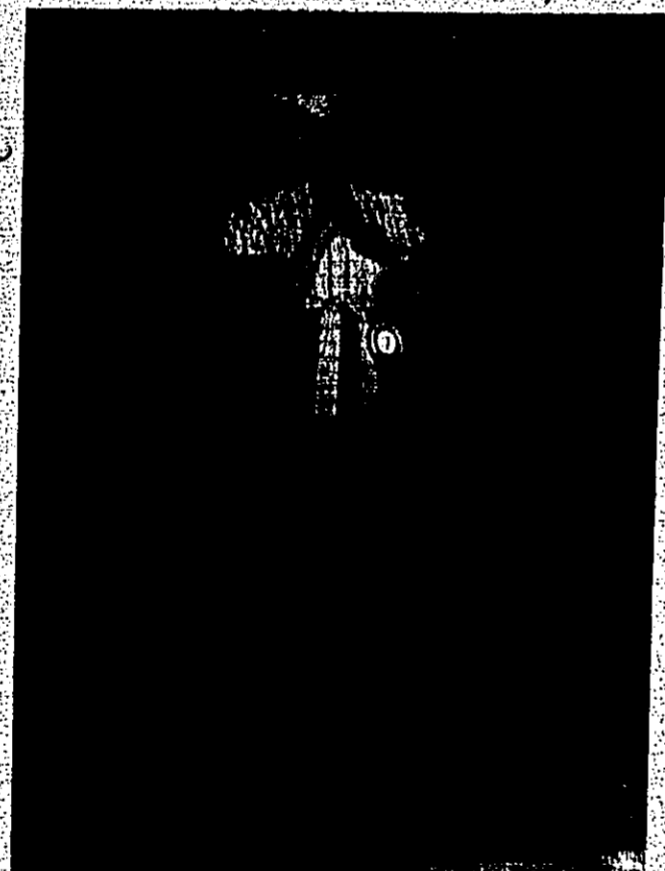
