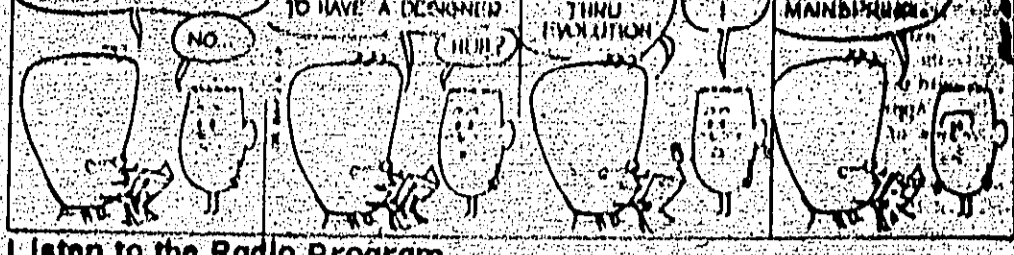
Warren-Hyatt Happenings Colmesneil Column

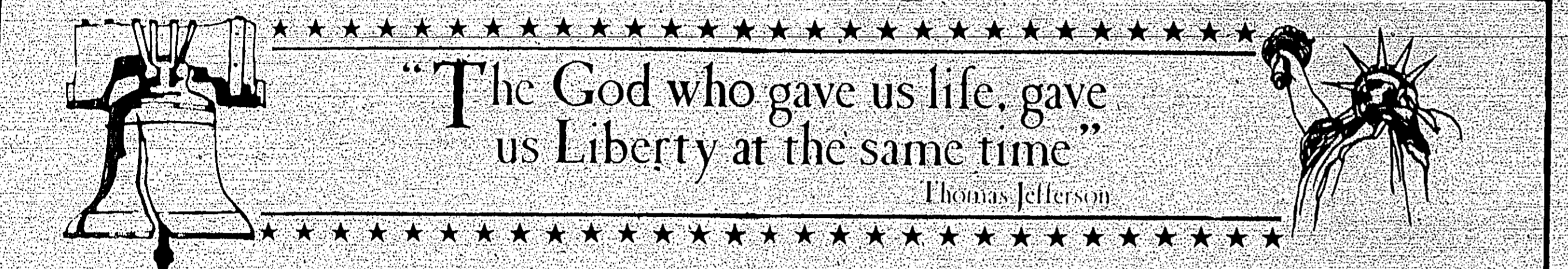

Something to Remember from THE Monroe Doctrine

DECEMBER 2, 1823

We owe it to candor, and to the amicable relations existing between the United States and those powers, to declare that we should consider any attempt on their part to extend their system to any portion of this hemisphere as dangerous to our peace and safety. With the existing colonies or dependencies of any European power we have not interfered and shall not interfere. But with the governments who have declared their independence and maintained it, and whose independence we have, on great consideration and on just principles, acknowledged, we could not view any interposition for the purpose of oppressing them, or controlling in any other manner their destiny, by any European power, in any other light than as the manifestation of an unfriendly disposition toward the United States. It is, therefore, the policy of the allied powers, should they extend their political system to any portion of either continent without our consent, and in defiance of our peace and happiness; not, in any other belief, that our southern brethren, if left to themselves, would adopt it of their own accord. It is equally impossible, therefore, that we should behold such interposition, in any form, with indifference.

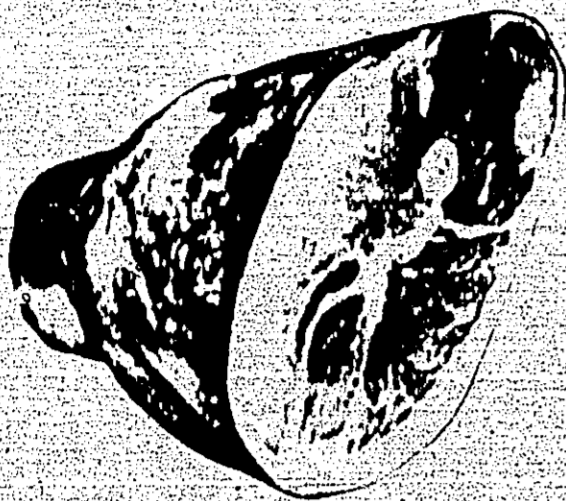
