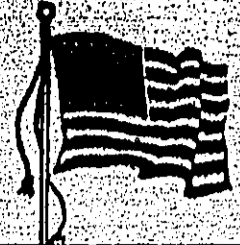

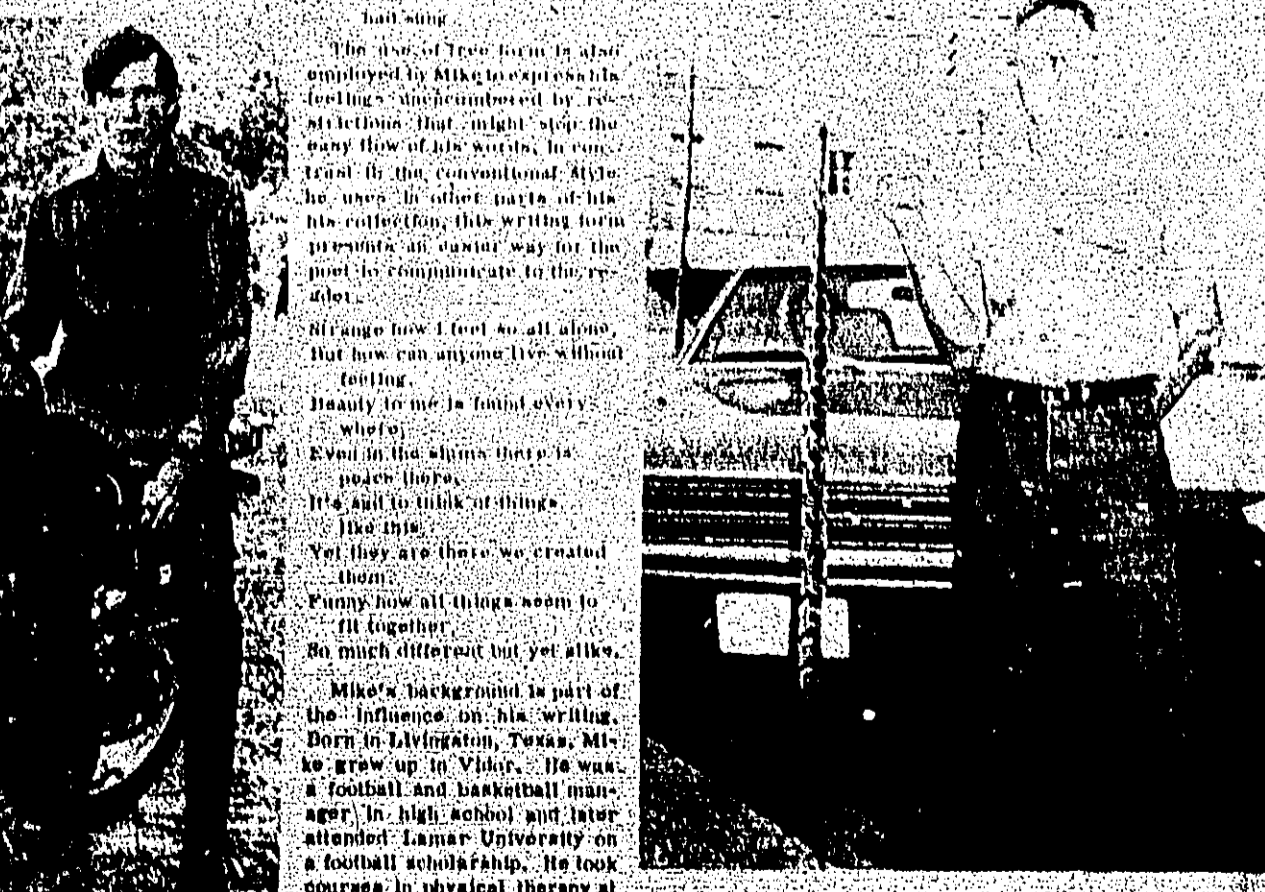

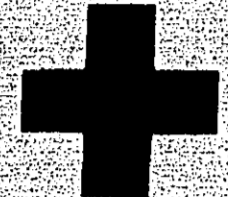

**The Mayflower Compact: 'Just and Equal' laws**

On September 16, 1620 a group of 102 Pilgrims sailed from Plymouth, England, to find a new free world. On November 21, 1620 their ship, the Mayflower, anchored at what is now known as Provincetown, Mass. Before anyone went ashore, the Pilgrim leaders persuaded almost everyone aboard to sign an agreement since known as the "Mayflower Compact". It was the "first" plan for self-determining government ever put forth in America. Those who signed it agreed to set up a government that would make "equal and just laws" and they promised to obey such laws whenever the leaders decided upon them. And that's how it all began, 352 years ago.
