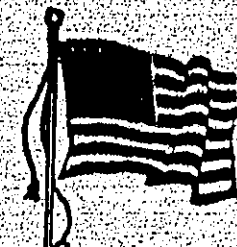

## 21 Persons Booked at Jail In Weekend

The Hon. Court of the Tyler County Jail booked 21 persons who were arrested by officers on a variety of charges.

As usual, 10 were intoxicated and being drunk in public. Five were charged with DWI and six with being drunk.

Three persons were charged with disorderly conduct. Three others, two from Louisiana and one from Mississippi, were arrested by Highway Patrol officers for possession of marijuana.

Game law violation accounts for two of the county's arrests. One person was caught driving without a valid driver's license. A woman was picked up for passing worthless checks (two counts).

One of the arrests for DWI also was charged with carrying a prohibited weapon. By Monday afternoon all of those arrested had either entered pleas of guilty and paid fines or, in the more serious charges, made bond.

## Mann Elected Chairman Of Finance Commission

Robert A. Mann, president of First Southwood Branch and chairman of the board of Citizens State Bank of Woodville, was elected chairman of the Finance Commission of Texas at a Saturday meeting of the commission.

Mann, a leading figure in state banking circles, has served as a member of the State Finance Commission for the past 6 years. In his new position he replaces V. M. Newbain of Mission.

The State Finance Commission is charged with supervising operations of the State Banking Department, State Savings and Loan Department and State Consumer Credit Department. The commission also appoints the chairman of each of the departments.

Mann bought controlling interest in First National Bank in Waco in December of 1969. He and his wife and three children moved there early in 1970, after Waco was picked as headquarters for his banking organization.

A third-generation banker, Mann, 41, was born and raised in Woodville, where his father and grandfather had been in the banking business. He took over operation of the bank after his father died in 1958 and made the decision to "specialize" in the banking business.

Mann is active in the Taylor-Waco Foundation, Waco Rotary Club and other organizations.

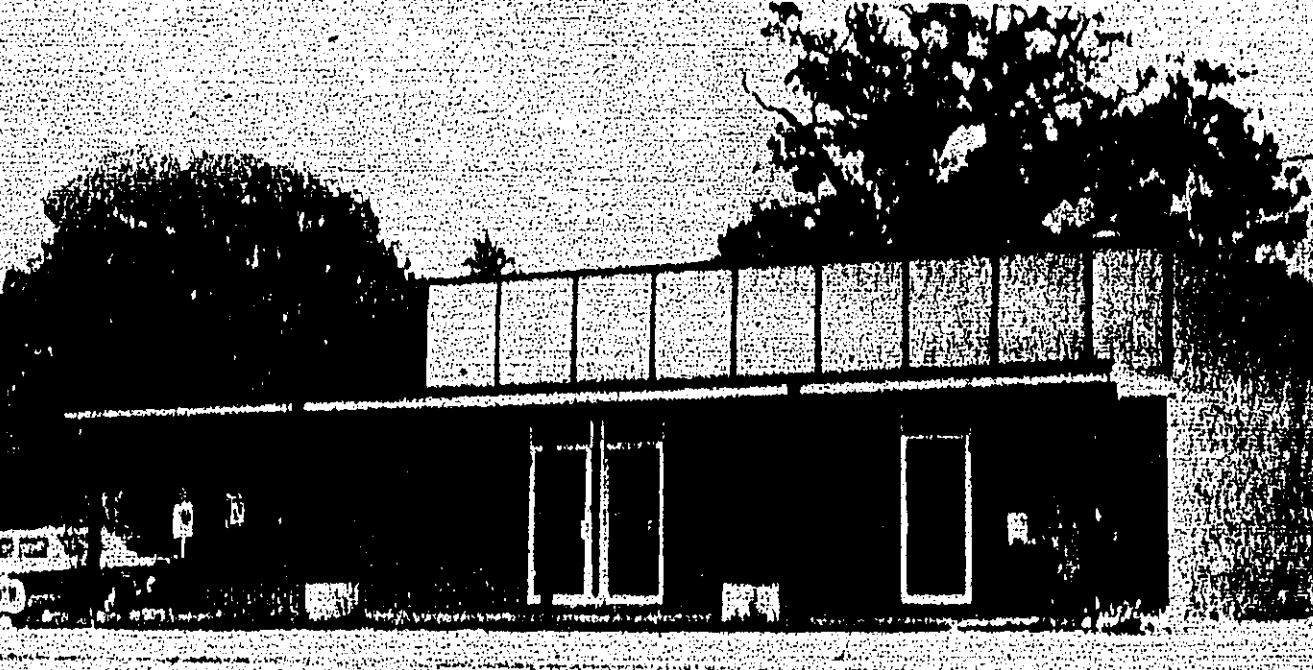

## Trustees Point Out Need For School Building Program

The bond election to be held Saturday, October 7, in the Woodville Independent School District will determine whether the board of trustees will be authorized to issue up to \$1,000,000 in bonds for a proposed building program and whether the school board unanimously agrees to submit for the continued growth of the school system.

The election will be held at the primary building of the Woodville Elementary School, which is located on South Wade Street. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. In a statement this week, school officials said the building program is another effort on the part of the school board and the trustees to continue the dedication to provide adequate, up-to-date and decent facilities for all the pupils of the district. The board is the district's representative body and it is the trustees' responsibility to provide for the district's future. ## Highway Death Toll Is 9 Through August

Although there have been three fatal traffic accidents on Tyler County highways the first eight months of 1972 the death toll has nearly doubled according to the monthly summary by Sergeant C. L. Taylor of the Texas Highway Patrol.

Through August there were 122 fatal traffic accidents in the county in which nine persons were killed and another injured. During the same period in 1971 there were 125 accidents in which five persons were killed and 93 injured.

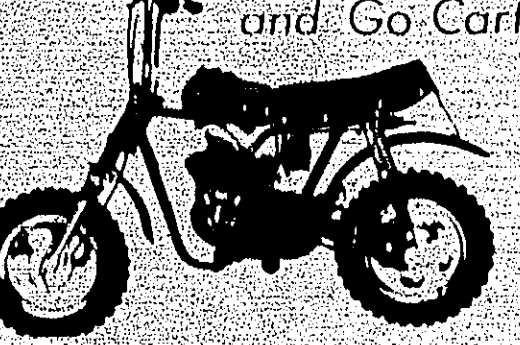
