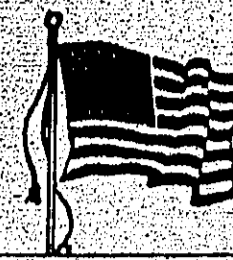

Registration Deadline Friday For November Vote

Deadline for registering to vote in the November 7 general election is today, Friday.

Any other eligible voter who has not registered should do so by Friday in order to be able to vote in the presidential, state, district and county general election.

Voter registration is handled by the tax assessor-collector office in the courthouse square.

Texas' new continuous registration law, passed by the Legislature in 1971 stipulates that new voters must register at least 30 days before the election in which they intend to cast a ballot. That makes October 6 an important date for those who have not registered under the new law.

Once a voter has registered he only needs to cast a ballot once each three years in a primary election to remain registered.

Applications for a registration certificate may be obtained at the county tax office.

Persons who have just reached 18 years of age and others who have not registered to vote will have to do so by October 9 if they want to vote in the General Election on November 7.

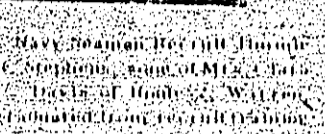
