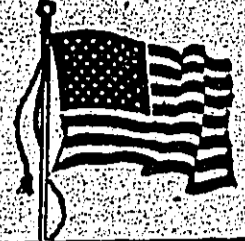

Belt and Bell To Cook Hamburgers Scout Fund Drive To Begin With Urland Party Monday

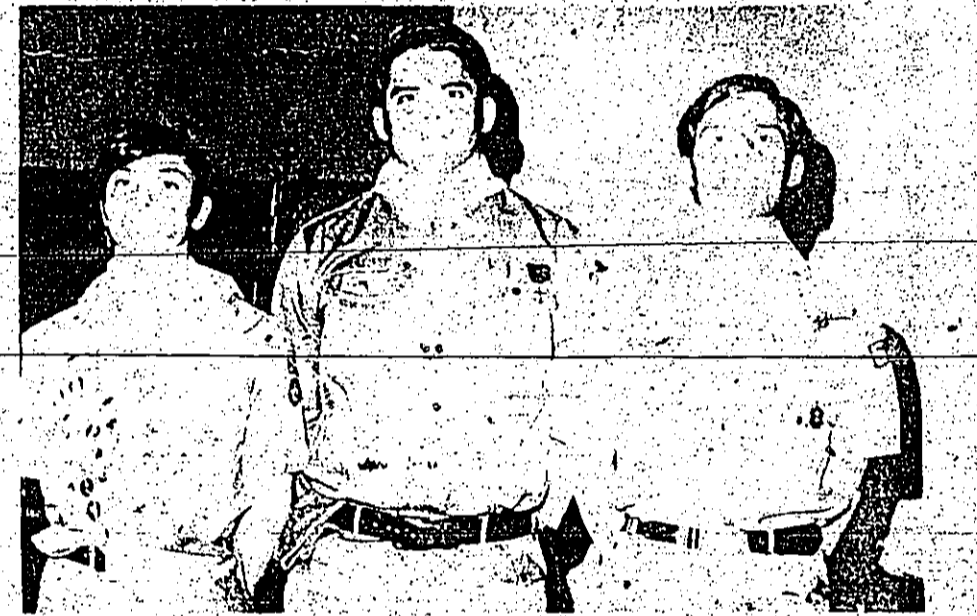

District Court for the Eastern District of Texas, will be principal speaker for the February meeting of the Deep East Texas Development Association Friday, February 23, at 10:00 a. m. at the Holiday Inn in San Augustine. Announcement of the meeting was made by W. F. (Bill) Miranda, Deep East Texas Development Association president from Jasper.

"We are extremely proud to announce that Judge Fisher will address our meeting in his native San Augustine, and we look forward to a very informative presentation.

Reports from various state and federal agencies and organizations will be made during the business meeting of the Deep East Texas Development Association, President Miranda said. Also outstanding committee reports will be heard during the session.

The Development Association is composed of eight counties in Deep East Texas including Sabine, San Augustine, Shelby, Nacogdoches, Jasper, Newton, and Tyler.

Judge Fisher is a member of a pioneer Texas family who settled in Texas prior to 1840. He is the son of Mrs. Lula Bland Fisher and the late Guy B. Fisher of Bland Lake.

Judge Fisher is a graduate of San Augustine High School, attended college in Houston and Stephen F. Austin State University. He received the University of Texas in 1936. He served as county attorney in San Augustine from 1937 until 1939 when he was elected District Attorney of the First Judicial District of Texas, serving until 1946. He practiced law in Jasper from 1946 until 1956. In 1957 he served one term as District Judge of the First District. In 1959 he was appointed as a judge of the U. S. District Court, was named Chief Judge in 1967.

Judge Fisher is a member of the Lions International Hall of Fame and served as a member of the Lions International board of directors. He also served as a district Lions Club governor.

The Board of Trustees of the Colmesneil Independent School District unanimously approved a resolution in their regular meeting of February 5 granting \$3,000 of the assessed value of residence homesteads of persons sixty-five years of age or older.

GM Scholarships Available

General Motors recently announced the continuation of its Scholarship Plan for the fall of 1973, beginning the nineteenth year of the plan. Scholarships will be awarded by 124 participating colleges and universities to 136 outstanding secondary school graduates. The awards will be made to entering freshmen and may be renewed through the normal four undergraduate years for those with satisfactory records.

While the colleges have full discretion in the allocation of GM scholarships and in the selection of students, they have been asked to give preference to those applicants who look forward to careers in industry. For example, those institutions which offer programs in engineering are urged to select highly qualified young people who are interested in this field of study. Colleges which do not offer degrees in engineering are being asked to select students in business administration, economics, mathematics and science. Seniors at all Tyler County High Schools may apply. Edith Finley, county supervisor, counselor said.

General Motors established its scholarship plan in 1955 with the guidance of leading educators. To date, General Motors has helped more than

8,000 able students to go to college, including 5,000 scholars who have received their baccalaureate degrees. Over 80% of these GM scholars plan to enter the top quarter of their classes and a majority plan to continue their education at the graduate and professional levels. Many of these talented young people are already beginning to make substantial contributions to their professions and communities. Of the colleges awarding scholarships in 1973, 63 are private and 61 are public institutions. Scholarship committees of these institutions review the student applicant's secondary school records, available entrance test scores, participation in extracurricular activities and leadership traits. Stipends range from \$200 to \$2,000 per year depending on demonstrated need. Private colleges receive varying amounts according to the tuition rate charged, from a minimum of \$500 to a maximum of \$800 per year for each scholarship. GM scholars should be citizens of the United States. Interested students should see their principal or counselor for a complete listing of the participating colleges, then apply directly to the institutions of their choice. No GM application is necessary.
