## Top of the Morning

Voters in Texas will have the opportunity to vote on nine proposed amendments in November's general election. Each week we will try to explain one of the amendments so that you may have the opportunity to study them and decide whether to vote for or against any of them or all of them.

The first amendment on the ballot will be S.J. R. 8 on annual sessions and legislative salaries. The amendment provides for an annual salary of \$15,000 for members of the state legislative and annual sessions of the Legislature of not more than 180 days in odd-members years and a 60 day session in even-numbered years. The shortest session would be authorized to deal only with fiscal matters and emergencies submitted by the governor, who could extend the short session by 30 days.

Proponents of the salary increase to \$15,000 from the present \$4,800 believe this salary would tend to keep legislators honest and make them less susceptible to lobbyist.

Dr. William A. Stanneyer, associate professor at Georgetown University and director of the Center for Law and Education is quoted in *The Wall Street Journal* as saying, "A major reason that crime has gone up 11 times faster than population that is shrinking is destroying the family business, that bus drivers, that drug abuse is leeching away the lives of 10 percent of our high school children, that airline passengers face daily risk of hijack, that a rape occurs every 15 minutes... is that just when we need more effective law enforcement the courts have set out generally to render it impotent. Just when we most need to strengthen the certainty of sanction, we weaken it. We have seen to it that crime does pay."

Cystic Fibrosis (C/F) is not a vague, obscure or rare disease. It affects one in every 1,500 babies, the result of both parents carrying the gene for C/F. It affects the entire body, particularly the lungs and digestive system. So far, it's incurable. When a group of parents of C/F children formed the National Cystic Fibrosis Research Foundation seventeen years ago, they knew very little about cystic fibrosis. Even the name "Cystic Fibrosis" was new; the disease wasn't recognized medically until the late 1930's. What those parents did know was terrifying. C/F children usually died before they were old enough for elementary school. Today that beginning has grown into a national organization which raises funds through the Breath of Life Campaign in local communities. There are over 300 chapters and branches of the National Foundation to advise and help parents and administer local programs and fund raising. There are more than 100 C/F Centers where not just C/F patients, but children with asthma, chronic bronchitis, bronchiectasis and childhood emphysema can be diagnosed and treated using the most sophisticated methods known.

## Southwestern Bell Announces Rate Adjustment On Long Distance Telephone Calls

Southwestern Bell announced an adjustment of telephone rates for long distance calls within Texas which will produce an after-tax revenue gain of less than \$12 million (\$23 million before taxes) to the company. This amounts to a little less than 2% of the company's total operating revenues in Texas. T. O. Gravit, vice president for Southwestern Bell operations in Texas, said the new rate schedule will increase the cost of most three-minute intrastate calls from a few cents to a dime. The change is effective September 24. Rates for local service and charges for long distance calls to other states will not be affected. One-Plus calls within Texas, which constitute about three-fourths of the calls, will generally be lower than the average for 41 other states offering a One-Plus rate. The other states do not have a One-Plus rate schedule. On calls requiring an operator, Texas rates generally compare favorably with other states, with some states higher and some lower.

The increase on long distance rates in Texas is expected to partially offset sharp increases in the cost of doing business, Gravit said. He cited that telephone wages for 1973 will be \$10 million higher than in 1971, and taxes for the year will be \$40 million more than two years ago when the last intrastate rate adjustment was made.

## Woodville School Enrollment 1,593

Classes started last week for students of the Woodville Independent School District with a slight decrease in enrollment from the last school year according to Superintendant, Dr. J. C. McGuire. The decrease in enrollment for the year is due to the McGuire School Improvement Plan at the end of the first week of school for the 1973-74 year was 1,649. The 1973 enrollment is 1,593, a decrease of 56 pupils from last year.

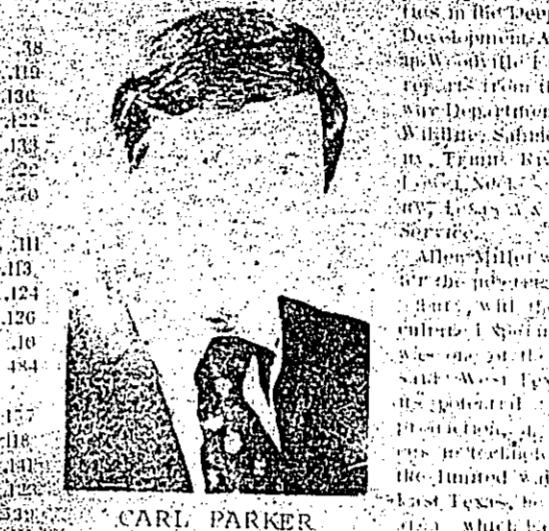

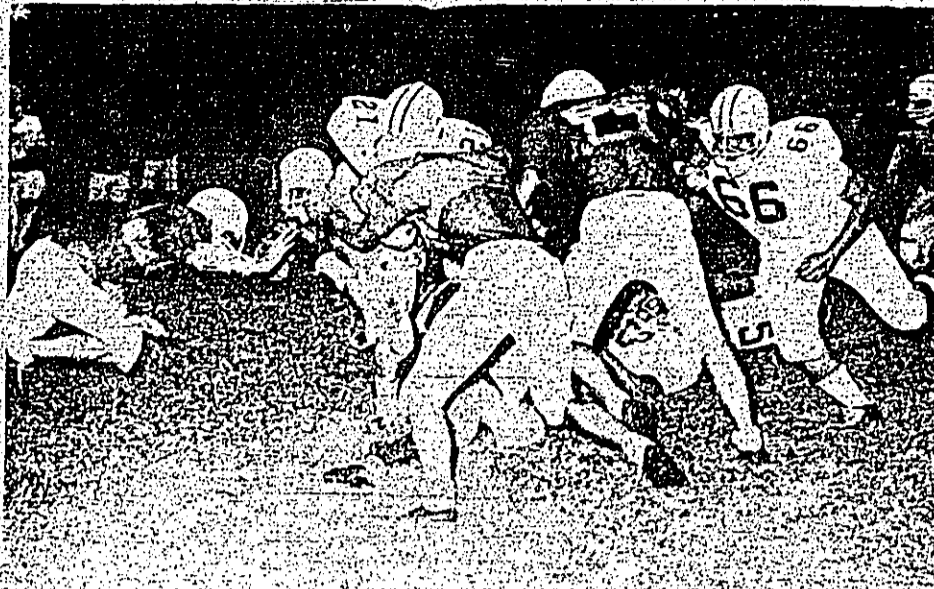

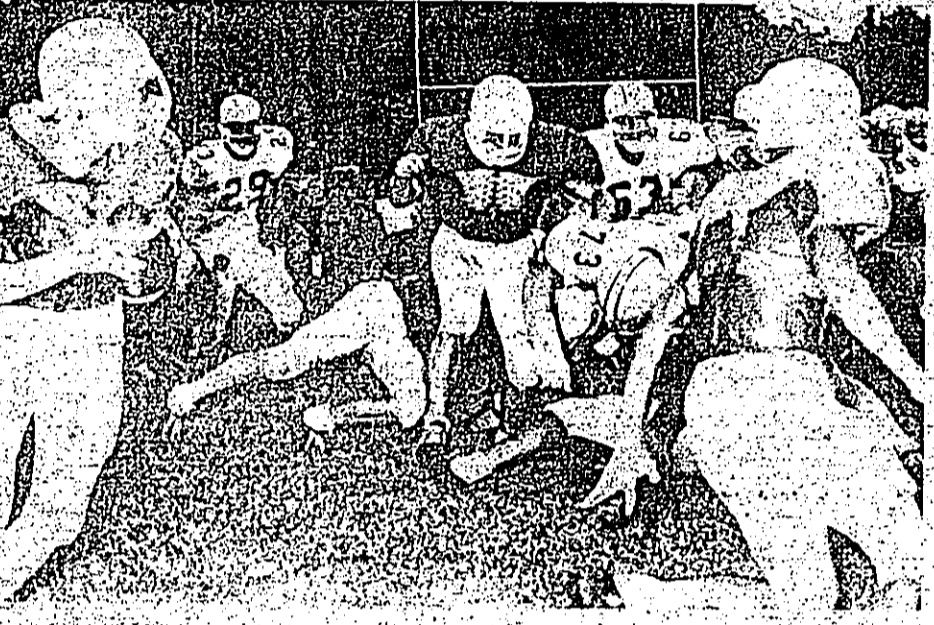

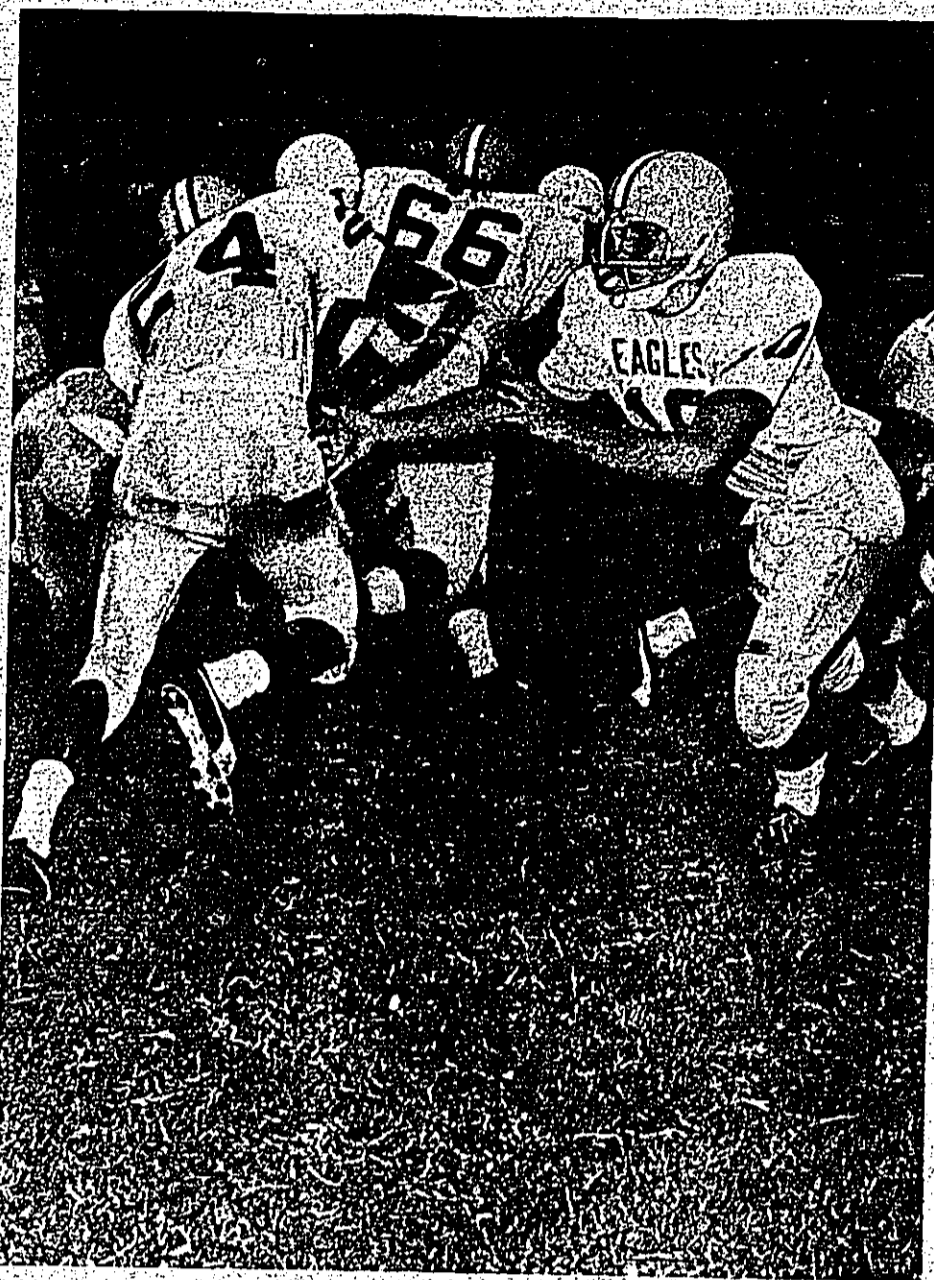

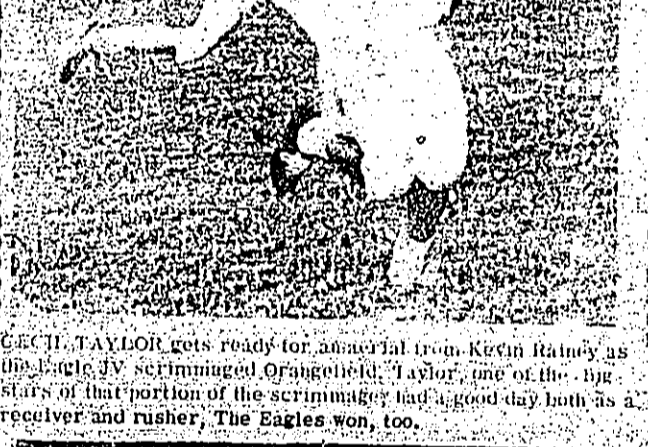

"Because the rent for the apartment was high, Henderson figured he could do pretty much as he pleased with the elegant furnishings. During his occupancy he broke two valuable lamps, left a costly mirror and a painting, and scattered the antique furniture with ungentle stairs. When the landlord demanded reimbursement for the damage, Henderson said he could not be held liable for 'reasonable wear and tear.' But a court saw things the landlord's way and ordered Henderson to make good."



If you are renting a house or apartment, chances are that somewhere in your lease there is a clause about reasonable wear and tear. This puts common-sense limits on the use you can make of the premises. In other cases, courts have held it wrongful when the tenant has done more than a man of ordinary prudence would do in the ordinary course of life. A tenant is not required to renovate the premises at the expiration of his lease.

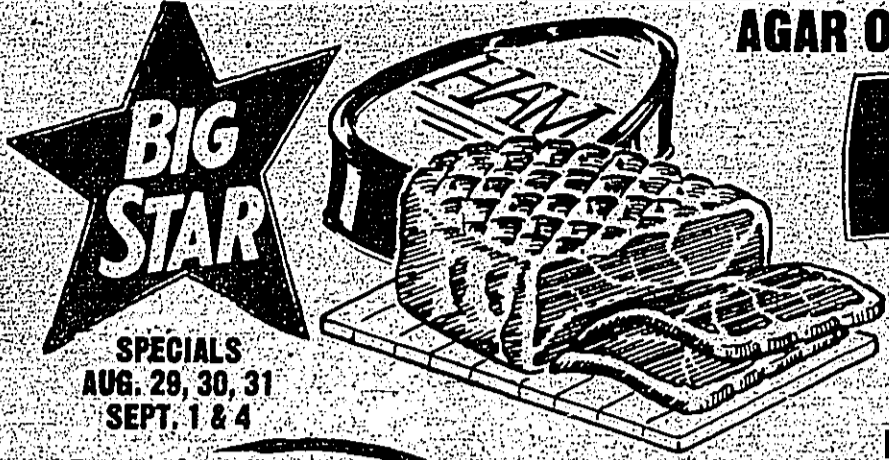

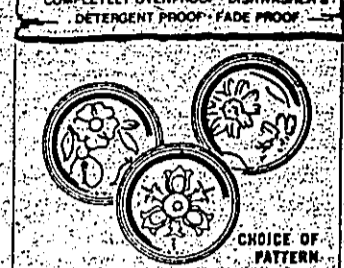
