## Top of The Morning

If we live by the Spirit, let us walk by the Spirit. Galatians 5:25

The situation into which the United States has found itself with regard to the energy shortage is amusing to other countries as one London news correspondent reports. The reporter said "The British have no sympathy for the energy dilemma in America, rather they seem somewhat amused that the United States, the most advanced technological and industrial nation in the world, is creating its own crisis by failing to develop its abundant resources. The average Britisher finds it hard to believe that the United States can have a real power supply shortage on the one hand and the Alaskan oil fields on the other. They wonder how can the United States be serious about an energy crisis when it has enough coal and nuclear technology to easily supply the nation through the 21st century. Britain has no energy crisis, according to the reporter because the British have accepted the atom as a way of life. England, he says, is considered to be the most advanced nuclear nation in the world with 29 atomic reactors in operation. "Another point noted is that the British simply don't understand the consumer protection desire and the manner in which the public opinion is swayed by environmental lobbies. The phenomenon is hard for a lot of Americans to understand too -- Americans who have lived in a country that has been envied by the rest of the world because of its abundance, initiative and willingness of its citizens to push back frontiers and move forward."

The medical profession and the American Cancer Society have spent millions of dollars urging the public to see a doctor at the first signs of cancer. But, according to a Massachusetts General Hospital study, these educational programs have accomplished little in the way of persuading the public to act fast to save their own lives. The study said that the waiting period today is much the same as that reported in similar studies at the same hospital 30 and 50 years ago. Researchers found that one in five patients saw a doctor in the first week after the systems were first noticed, two thirds waited longer than a month, 39 percent longer than three months and 25 percent longer than six months. The hospital's findings help explain why cancer is still the nation's second largest killer, and why 166,600 people per 100,000 population died because of it in 1972.

This nation has the finest medical system in the world. It can treat cancer and other potentially deadly diseases -- providing they are detected early enough. Unfortunately, no one can make a person see a doctor. That is the individual's responsibility. With our lives at stake, it is one none of us can afford to shirk.

The theme of the American Cancer Society's November Crusade is worth repeating: "We want to wipe out cancer in your lifetime." Those nine words speak

## 1973 big for Farm Bureau

WACO—(Sp)—1973 has been a banner year in membership for the Texas Farm Bureau, reports TFB President J. T. Woodson. The organization scored its biggest membership gain in history, he said.

Total membership as of October 31 (end of the organization's fiscal year) was 152,380 member families, a gain of 15,437 over last year, making the 21st straight year for the TFB to show an increase in members. Tabulations were completed November 6.

All of the 209 organized county Farm Bureaus registered an increase in membership.

The five largest counties in membership size are: (1) Harris—2,541; (2) Ellis—2,302; (3) McLennan—2,025; and (4) Fayette—2,000.

Woodson said farmers and ranchers have enjoyed most favorable prices for their products this year that they have recorded in a long time.

But they have felt themselves under fire by intermittent threats of price controls on raw farm products and embargoes on farm exports, he explained. "These fears have caused them to rally behind an organization which could effectively speak for them against such threats," he added.

## INCREASES

Citizens of Woodville can expect the best trained and equipped police force in the city's history, according to Woodville Police Chief Bruce D. Gravis.

The three-man police department offers well over 20 years of law enforcement experience to Woodville. Chief of Police Bruce D. Gravis studied at Lamar University for two years in Pre-Law. He also studied Law Enforcement at Lamar while taking his basic training in police work with the Beaumont Police Department. Chief Gravis has 3 years of experience with the Beaumont Police Department and 8 years of experience with the Jasper County Sheriff's Department. He studied Bachelor of Science in Police Administration at the Texas Department of Public Safety in Austin, and has attended numerous F.B.I. training schools.

Assistant Chief Garry G. Mattingly is a graduate of the Atlanta Police Academy. He also studied one year of Police Science at DePaul College in Decatur. Mattingly has experience with the Georgia State Police and served six years on the Atlanta Police Department.

Patrolman David L. Smith has 2 1/2 years experience on the Port Arthur Police Department. His studies at Lamar University included 18 hours in Police Science, Juvenile Justice, and Community Policing. Smith also has 6 hours of training in criminal investigations and three hours in traffic and report writing.

Chief Gravis reports that the Woodville Police Department has begun giving 24-hour

service to the city. In the future two police cars, painted black and white, will operate on patrol in the city.

Gravis also reported that the department has undergone a complete reorganization. A complete police manual has been presented to the City Council. A new record system is being initiated by the police department to aid in reorganization.

Corporation Court Judge T.E. Phillips occupies his office from 8:00 to 10:00 each morning. Phillips is on call 24 hours every day and may be reached at his home.

Chief Gravis and Judge Phillips issued a statement reminding the citizens of Woodville that laws will be strictly enforced in the City of Woodville. Those wishing to contact the police should call the sheriff's Department Dispatcher.

## D.P.S. Reports 24 Wrecks

Sergeant C.L. Taylor of the Texas Highway Patrol announced today that during the month of October 1973, in Tyler County, there were 24 Rural Fatal accidents in which 2 persons were killed. In addition, The Texas Highway Patrol investigated 24 rural motor vehicle accidents in which 22 persons were injured.

Through October of this year, there have been 207 rural accidents in Tyler County, killing 10 persons and injuring 115 people.

During the same 9 month period in 1972 there were 201 rural traffic accidents killing 13 and injuring 105 persons.

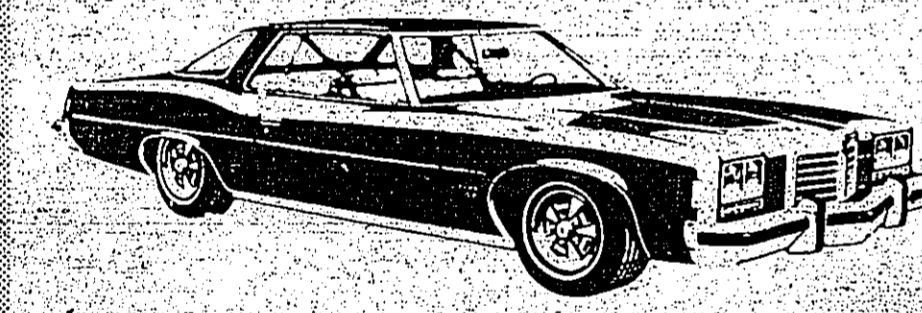

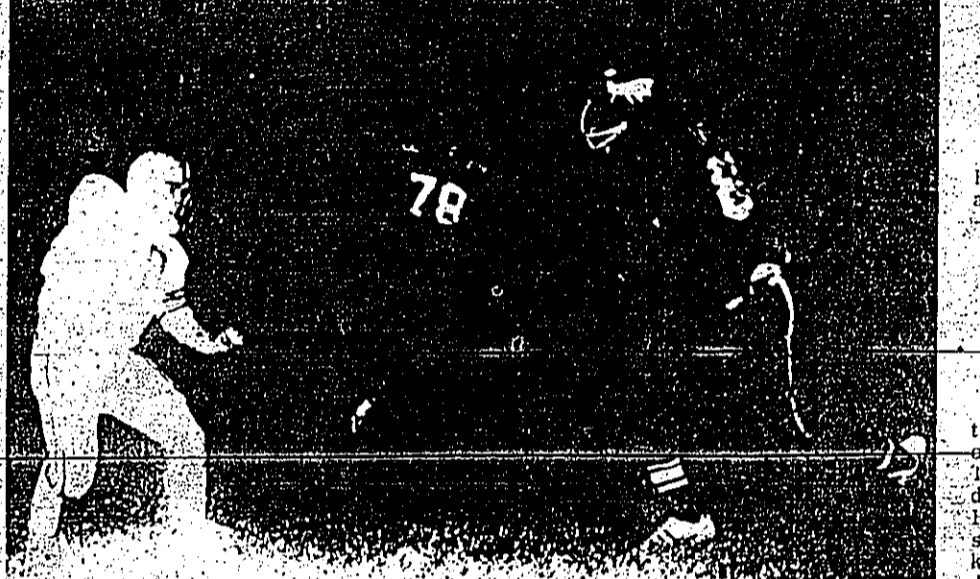

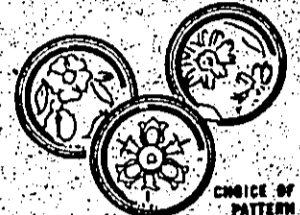
