THEY DON'T MAKE FURNITURE LIKE THEY USE TO

They don't make things like they use to, certainly describes the furniture industry. This is fortunate for the American consumer, says Chuck Slayton, area wood products specialist for the Texas Agricultural Extension Service.

Texas is a leading furniture manufacturing state, producing about three percent of the nation's total value of shipped furniture.

Appearance is important, but with modern manufacturing problems have been eliminated by modern drying in strength, dimensional stability (shrinking and swelling) and wood grain quality and price is definitely related to wood species and type. Materials such as gum, beech, geymore and yellow poplar in hidden furniture parts reduces the overall cost and still provides the quality of the wood. Solid hardwood or plywood.

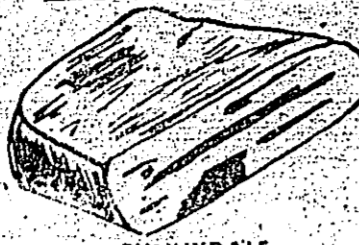
