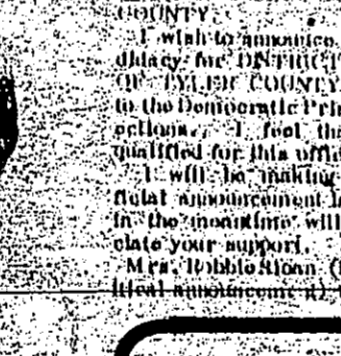

The Legislature called the session of 1973-74 to a close on December 27, 1973. The session was marked by a number of significant events, including the passage of several major bills and the adjournment of the session.

One of the key bills passed was the "Texas Education Code" which provides for a more uniform system of public education across the state. This bill was passed by a vote of 75-15 in the Senate and 145-10 in the House.

Another major bill was the "Texas Tax Code" which provides for a more uniform system of taxation. This bill was passed by a vote of 75-15 in the Senate and 145-10 in the House.

The session also saw the passage of several other bills, including the "Texas Health Code" and the "Texas Labor Code".

The session adjourned on December 27, 1973, with the Governor signing the bills into law.
