Because of the energy shortage, people are taking windmills seriously as a way to relieve pressure on fuels such as oil and coal. 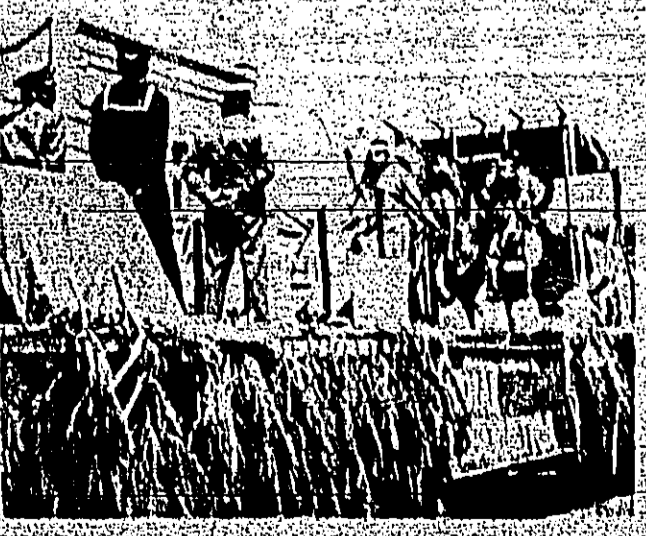

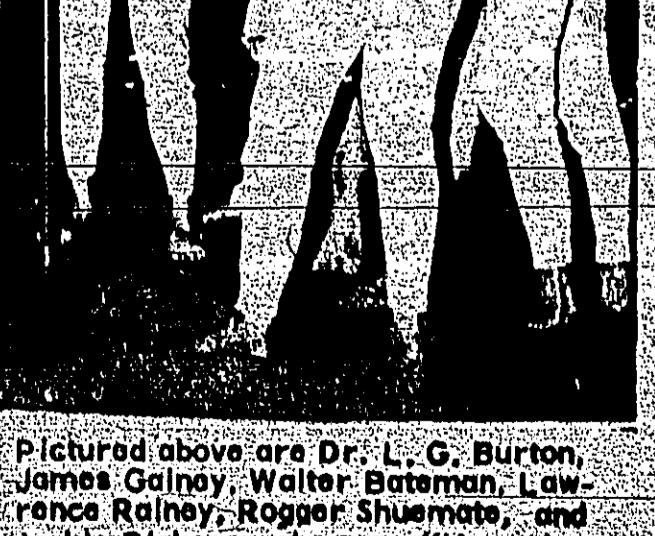
