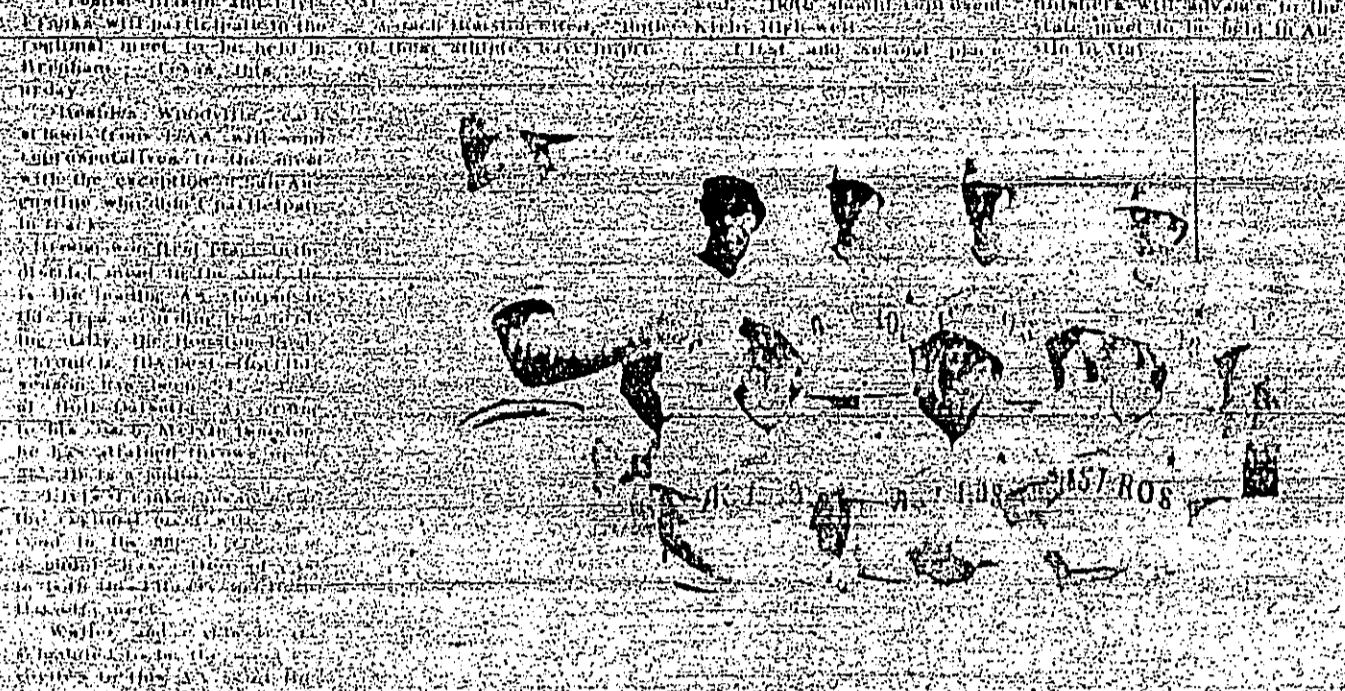

Woodville Drops Two District Baseball Outings

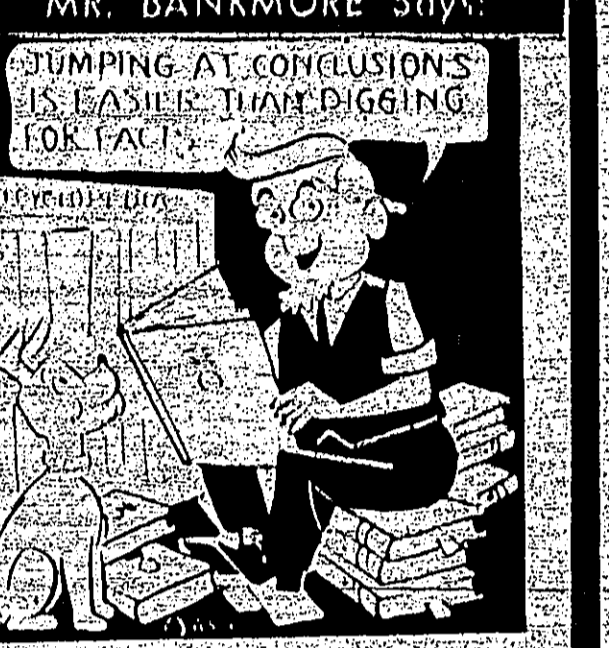
