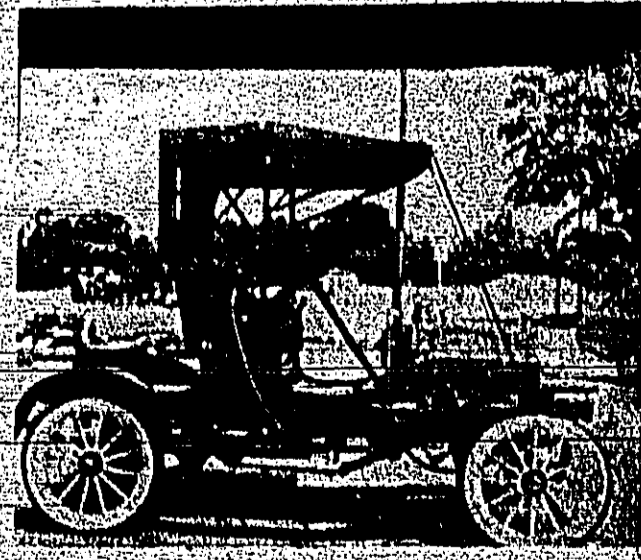
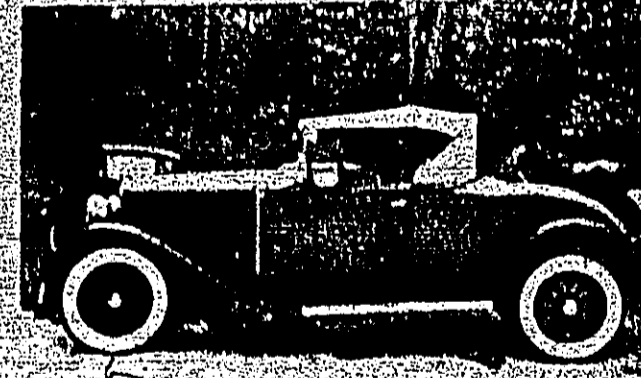

**RUSSIA TO GET 6% U. S. Loan**

Another million-dollar loan from the same folks who brought you the Russian wheat deal, was the way Congressman Charles Wilson (D-Texas) characterized the approval of a \$100 million loan from the U.S. Export-Import Bank to the Soviet Union.

The present Administration, which decided this loan, must be aware of the many Americans who can't afford to buy wheat from the Soviet Union.

At almost twice the international rate, we're charging the Russians," said the Texas Congressman.

"And we can't totally stabilize the wheat price, more than an 80 percent increase of the current price. It may not be an accident that the wheat price has risen to a level that is almost double the current price."

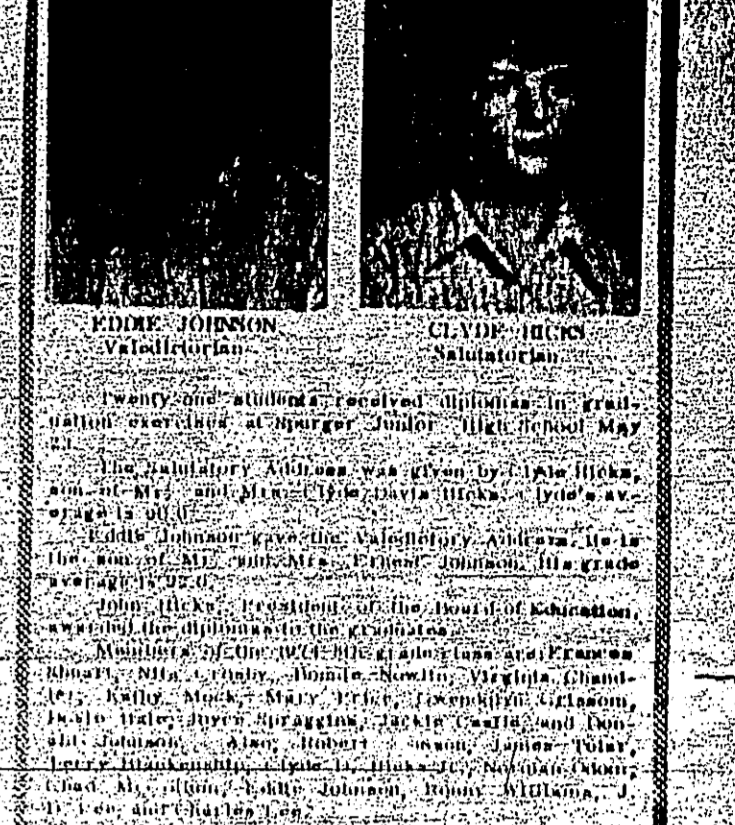

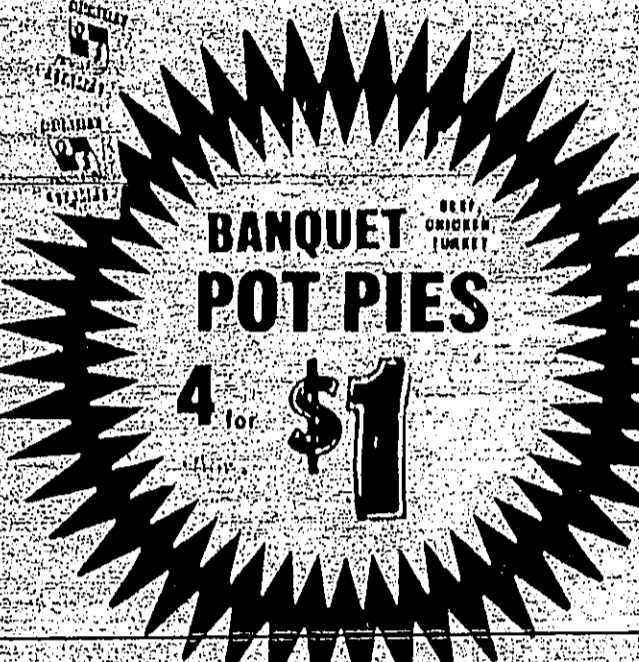
