Recorded production of oil in Tyler County goes back to 1927, with production continuing without interruption to the 20,049,030 through 1973. While this is not a great amount of production in comparison to some counties in Texas, it has contributed substantially to the economy of Tyler County. In 24 years of recorded oil production, Texas fields have produced approximately 69 million barrels of oil approximately 30 percent of the U.S. total. Our neighboring county, Angelina produces a barrel of oil per day. Jasper county, 696 barrels per day while Tyler County produces 19,540 per day.

As the prospect of passage of a National Health Insurance bill by Congress appears certain, the tax-burdened public should be cognizant of one thing. No matter what all-of-a-kind tricks are used to disguise the true costs of medical care, those costs will be paid by consumers and taxpayers. The \$40-billion a year National Health Insurance program proposed by the administration, provides that no family would have to pay more than \$1,600 per year for medical expenses. Under the plan, employers would pay 70 percent of the estimated \$200 annual premium. Employees would pay the rest. The cost to the nation that employers would be paying, the largest share of the cost. Commerce Secretary Frederick Herzog said that a 70% contribution to the health plan by the private employers would be a "substantial" role. He said, "Employers already face possible increases in costs of unemployment insurance, workers' compensation, health and pension plan reforms. They also are hearing their share for increases in Social Security. Taxes, minimum wage, corporate taxes and new taxes on safety, fire insurance. Any added costs of doing business imposed on them by the government must come out of business profits. Added costs often force the choice between cutting out of business or raising prices. Employees, in short, would not pay 70% of the cost. The cost will be paid one way or another by the nation's consumers."

\$47,720 GIVEN TO DETCOG BY GOV. BRISCOE

AUSTIN—Governor Dolph Briscoe has approved two grants totaling \$47,720 for improvements in criminal justice in the area served by the Deep East Texas Council of Governments. The grant of \$10,300 will provide second-year funding of the Deep East Texas legal aid project. The legal aid project is a county sheriff's office and municipal police departments in preparation of affidavits for search and seizure warrants, indictments and confessions in criminal cases.

Deep East Texas Council of Governments will also receive a regional planning grant of \$37,420 for development of a comprehensive criminal justice plan to serve the counties of Angelina, Bibb, Cherokee, Gregg, Harrison, Jasper, Kaufman, Newton, Polk, Sabine, San Jacinto, San Antonio, Shelby, Tarrant and Tyler.

The money comes from the Criminal Justice Division of the Governor's Office. CJD administers the state's block grant from the Law Enforcement and Corrections Administration under the Crime Control Act of 1970.

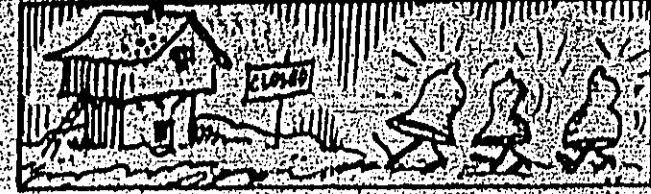

The Inn also features a large swimming pool and a tennis court. There are also several guest rooms available.

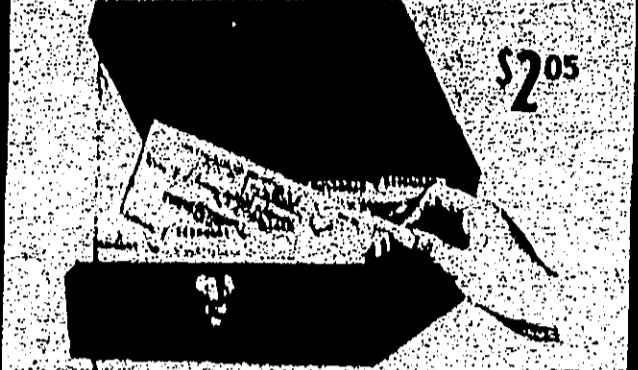
