ELECTION RETURNS GRATIFYING TO TYLER COUNTY DEMOCRATS

Tyler County followed the voting trend across the state and cast most of their votes for those candidates running on the Democratic Party ticket.

Disappointed Congressional candidate, Charles Whitman received 2036 votes from county residents. Governor, Breaux was given a second term in office with support from this county totaling 1084 votes to 466 cast for his opponent, Jim Mansberry. Ramsey Moody, also running for governor, gained only 57 votes while Sherry Smith netted 14 and S.W. McDaniel got 20.

John H. H. was elected as attorney general for the state, voters from this area gave him a total of 2036 votes. His opponent, Tom H. got 1403 supporters and Peter Vanover, Tyler County was first in their support of Bob Hallack for State Comptroller with 1097 votes. Nick Howe, candidate for Justice, received 377 votes and Sam Neumann, Justice, gained 203 votes from the county.

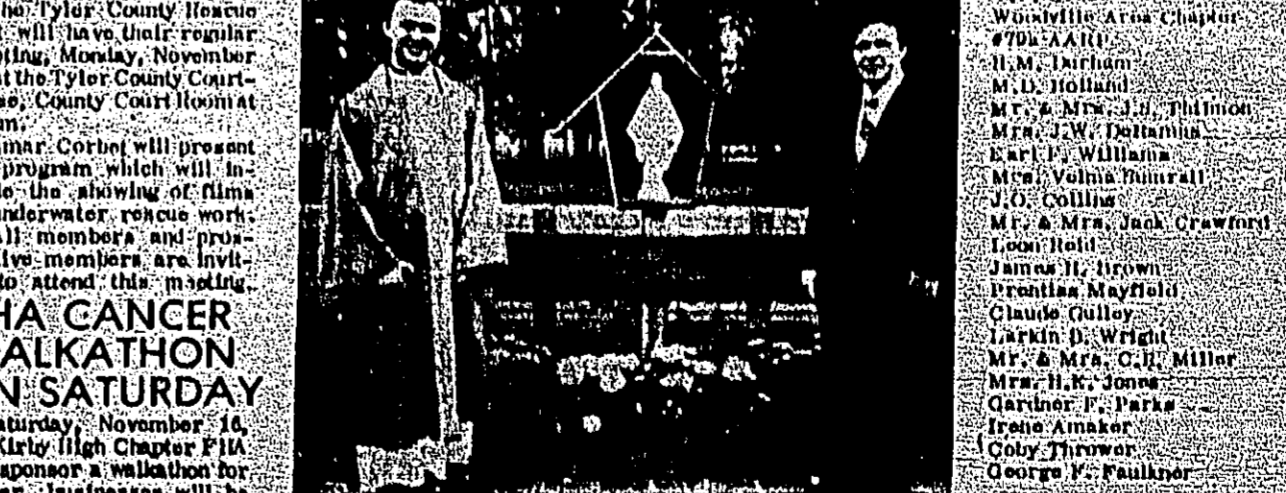

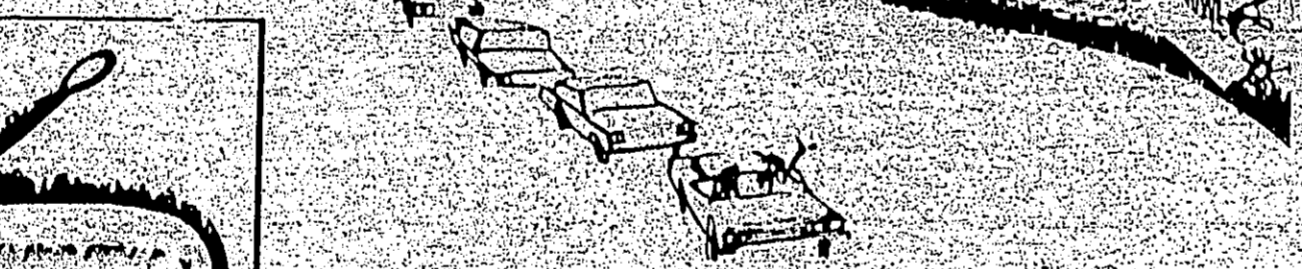

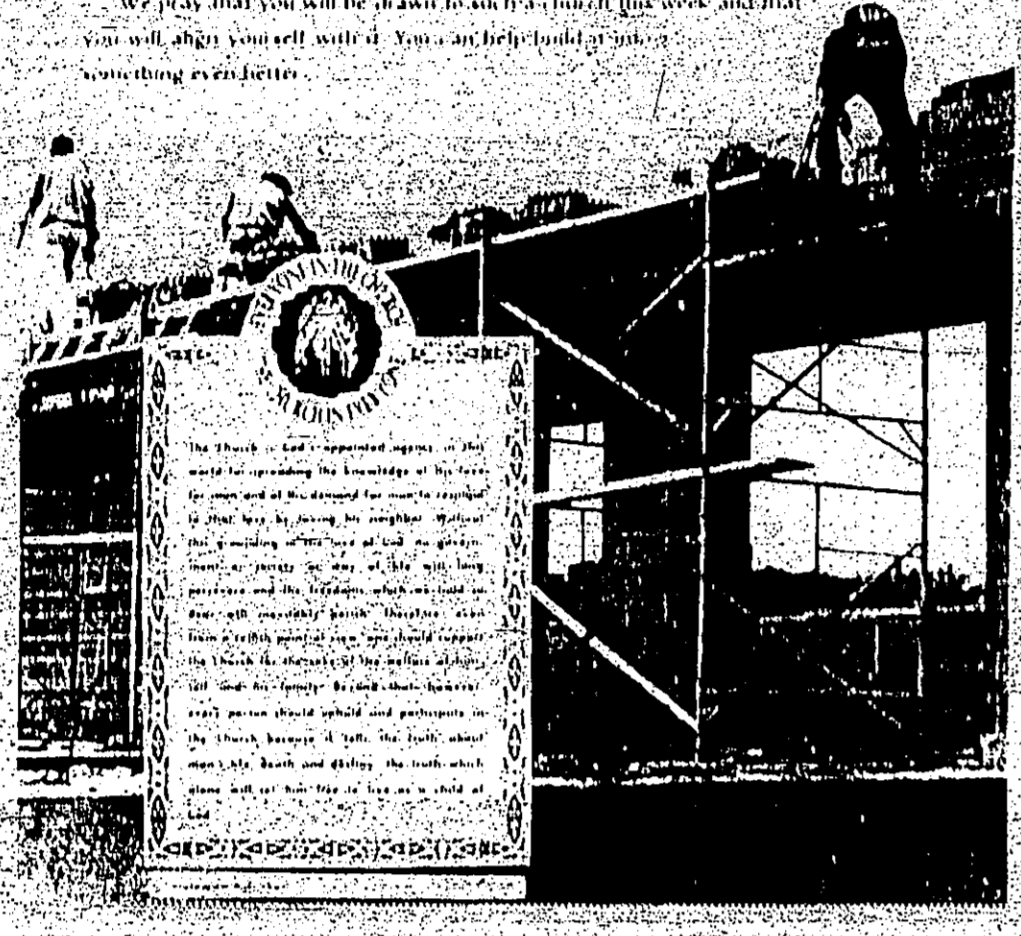

Christmas Package Mail-out Should Begin By November 18

Urging all customers to mail as early as possible, Postmaster Milton Dugan recommends the following dates by which residents of Woodville should deposit Christmas mail to the post office:

November 18 - Parcel Air Mail to all major foreign countries and Central America, the Caribbean, and Liberia; International airmail service starting to South America and Central America; and Europe.

November 20 - Parcel Air Mail to all major foreign countries in Australia, the Pacific, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Okinawa, Philippines, Thailand, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore, Guam, and the Virgin Islands; Greece, Italy, Norway, Sweden, and Portugal; and Mexico.

November 23 - Surface Mail to all major foreign countries in Australia, the Pacific, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Okinawa, Philippines, Thailand, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore, Guam, and the Virgin Islands; Greece, Italy, Norway, Sweden, and Portugal; and Mexico.

November 27 - Parcel Air Mail to all major foreign countries in Australia, the Pacific, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, New Zealand, Okinawa, Philippines, Thailand, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore, Guam, and the Virgin Islands; Greece, Italy, Norway, Sweden, and Portugal; and Mexico.

Insurance Policies Should Be Checked For Right Beneficiary

Make certain the right person is beneficiary on your life insurance policy, is the Veterans Administration reminder to five million policyholders under its government life insurance program.

Otherwise, you may add to emotional stress of survivors when it is discovered the intended beneficiary for your insurance policy is not the one named on the policy, VA Regional Director A. J. Hunter said.

In such cases, VA is alerted by law to pay insurance proceeds to the beneficiary of record. Most of the agency's insured are World War II veterans who served in the military service.

The problem of insurance benefits going to unintended recipients arises in most instances because the veteran has failed to update his beneficiary listing, he forgot to notify VA that he wished to change his beneficiary, the beneficiary died, or the beneficiary was a minor at the time the policy was issued.

Hunter urges any veteran who wishes to name an intended beneficiary to contact the VA insurance center in his area. The centers are in Philadelphia, St. Paul, and other major cities. The centers may also be contacted by calling or writing your local VA office.

In a special case, the veteran named his minor children as beneficiary when he first took out a life insurance policy. If he forgot to notify VA that he wished to change his beneficiary, the result often is that the minor children are named as beneficiary. This is because the VA insurance center is notified of the beneficiary listing at the time the policy is issued. The VA insurance center may also be contacted by calling or writing your local VA office.

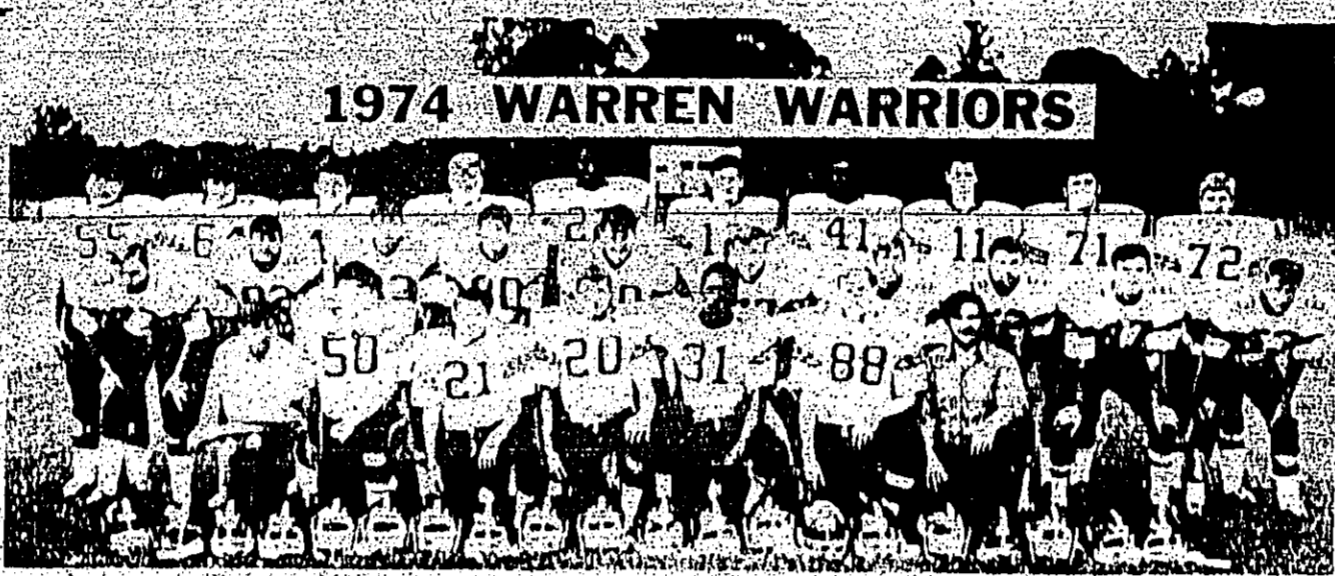
