Although we have inflation in America, we are still better off than most other countries when prices are compared. In Tokyo, Japan, beefsteak, sirloin, steak costs \$14.00 a pound; in Bonn, West Germany, steak costs \$5.00 a pound; in Copenhagen, \$3.00; in Stockholm, \$4.10; in Brussels, \$3.07 and in Canberra, Australia, \$2.45. In Buenos Aires, the government has set the price of steak at .07 a pound. The only problem with the 0.07 steak is there is none available. Incidentally, cigarette cost \$17.50 a pound.

Tyler County is one of the few rural areas to provide free bus service for some of its citizens and we wonder why more people do not use the service. The bus schedule has been planned so that each community in Tyler County will have bus service one day each week. The bus service is free to those who qualify. You may qualify to ride the bus if you are over 60 years of age or disabled, and have no other transportation, or unable to drive your own vehicle.

Application blanks must be filled out and approval made before you become eligible to ride the bus. You do not have to fill out an application each time you want to ride the bus. However, you should notify the bus office in advance of the day you intend to ride the bus.

Application blanks are available at any of the bus stops. From the driver, the County Extension Agents' office and the office of county clerk Tom Mann; or call the office at 853-8817 in Woodville. The office is located at 306 West Wharff. The bus schedule is printed on page six of this week's BOOSTER.

FIREPLACE SAFETY OFTEN IGNORED

Americans are using their home fireplaces today at a rate unprecedented in the history of the country. Fireplace industry sources say more than half of all new homes and apartments being built have some type of fireplace, and many fireplaces are being pressed back into service after years of disuse.

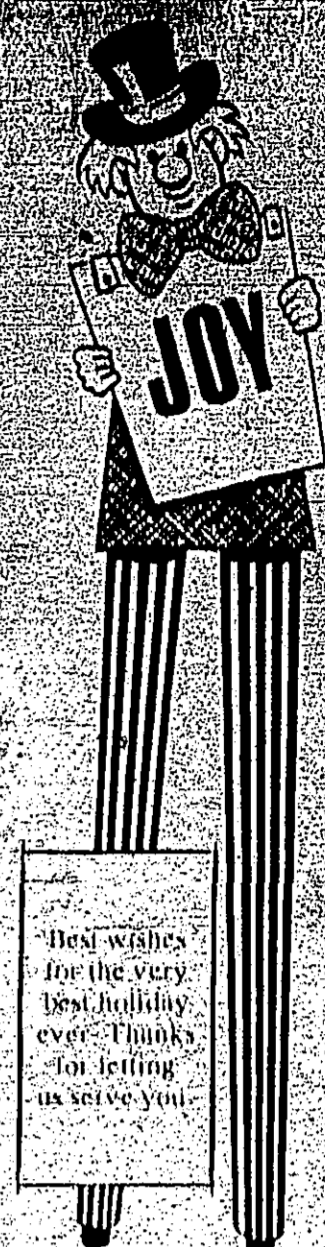
