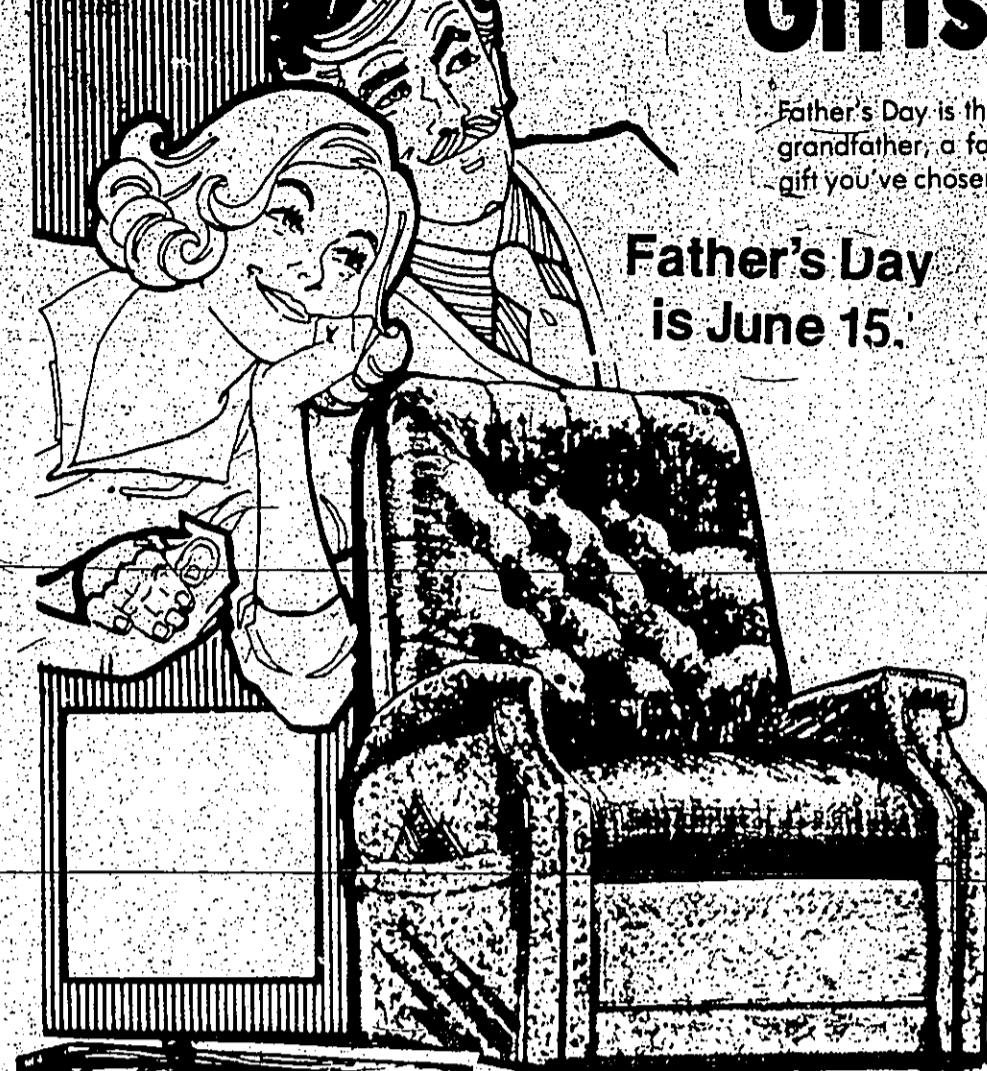

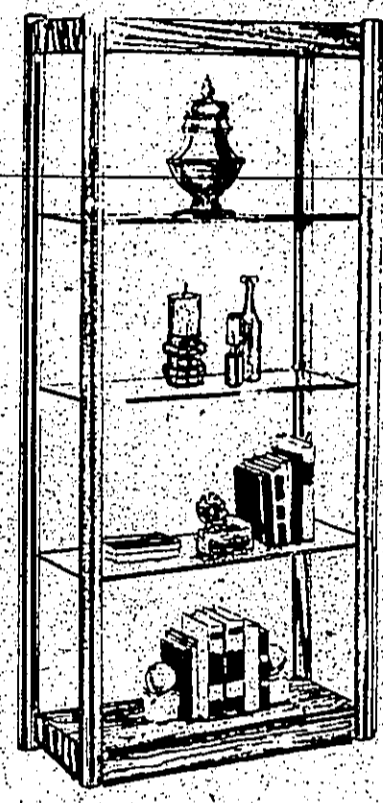

### Homemaking Hints

Yearly Checkup For Pressure Canner By *Bonnie Covington*  
A cleanup and checkup for the pressure canner is a real necessity before beginning the year's home canning. This helps insure a safe and high quality product. Clean removable petcocks and safety valves, using vinegar to remove any corrosion. Check gaskets for wear and replace if necessary. Use a toothpick, pipe cleaner or string. Check gaskets for tight fit and be sure it's free from grease and dirt. Use salt-free fat to grease the closing surface of lid that seals metal to metal. If it's difficult to remove or if steam escapes, use a wire brush. Tighten screws on handles. Use plumber's paste to close leaks that allow steam to escape.

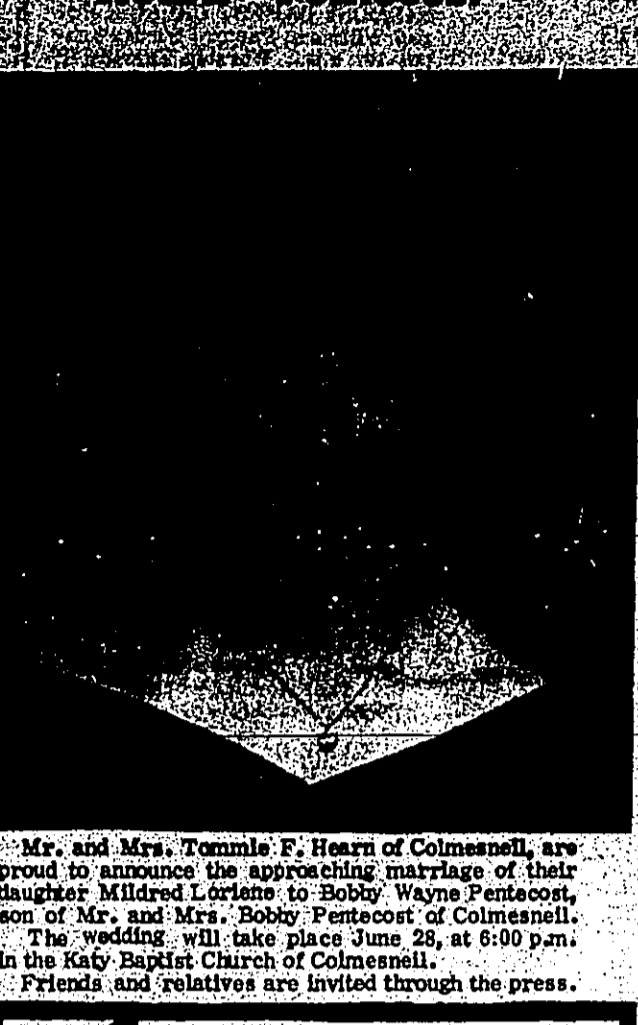

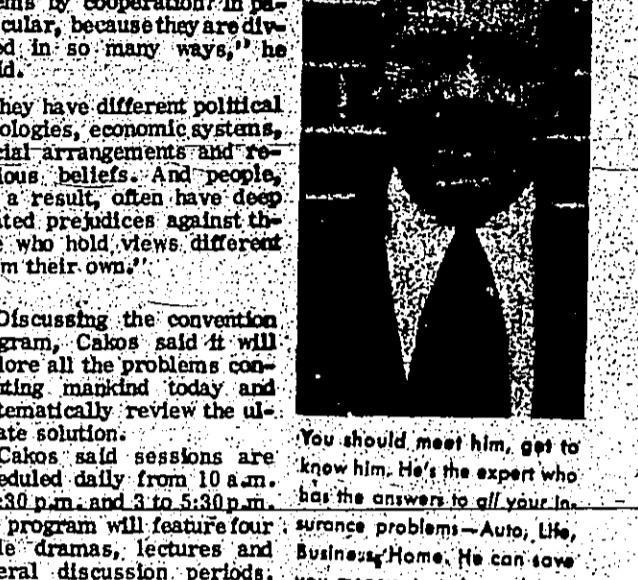
### Woodville Garden Club Given Two State Awards

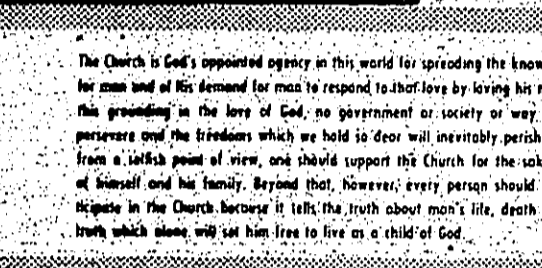

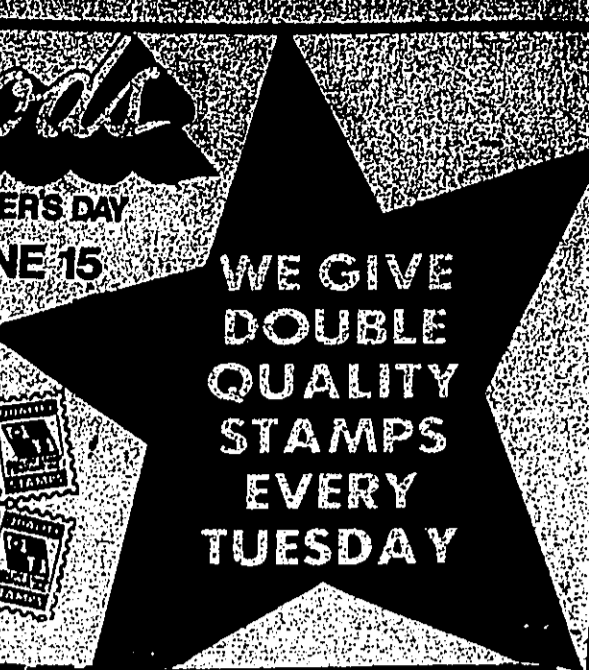
